Apologies for not getting back to you sooner; I'm just back from a few days' leave.
Essentially the basis of the concerns raised with us is the assertion that IPSA funding
is being used to support pro-Brexit campaigning activity. As confirmed in the last
assurance review, our position is that IPSA funding is used to pay for the research
and briefing materials produced by the ERG; and what MPs then do with that
information is not within IPSA's remit to regulate. I think I'm correct in saying that
the ERG has other sources of funding, which presumably can be used for
campaigning/party political activity if you so choose. That said, I would be grateful
for a further conversation with you about how this separation is maintained. We
clearly have a responsibility to seek assurance that IPSA funds are used in
accordance with the Scheme.
