Introduction

VOTE ON ACCOUNT FOR 2015-16

Schedule 1, paragraph 22 of the Parliamentary Standards Act 2009 requires the Independent Parliamentary Standards Authority to submit to the Speaker's Committee each financial year an estimate of the Authority's income and expenditure.

The Vote on Account provides finance to allow existing services to continue during the early months of the coming financial year, pending Parliament's consideration of the Independent Parliamentary Standards Authority's Resource Estimate for 2015-16.

The Vote on Account is presented in resource, capital and cash terms. For 2015-16, because of the General Election the amounts are higher than the standard 45% of the amounts already voted for the corresponding services in the current year. This is because the majority of the additional expenditure we are seeking through the Supply and Appropriation Act will be required prior to the passing of the Act. This amount should be sufficient to ensure that funding is not exhausted before the Supply and Appropriation Act is passed in the summer, but not so high as to prejudge Parliament's consideration of the main Supply Estimate.

This Vote on Account together with those for the House of Commons Administration(HC), National Audit Office (HC), Electoral Commission (HC), Local Government Boundary Commission for England (HC), and those for central government departments (HC) will be incorporated with Supply and Appropriation (Anticipation & Adjustment) Bill that follows presentation of the Supplementary Estimates 2014-15 and the Vote on Account, which will seek statutory authority for the issue from the Consolidated Fund of a sum equal to the Vote on Account.


