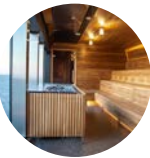

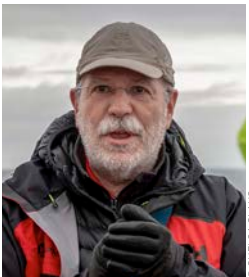

WILDLIFE

North America is home to a spectacular array of wildlife, from massive whales to high-flying eagles. We explore a wide range of rich ecosystems, and offer the opportunity to encounter the following memorable species.

EAST COAST



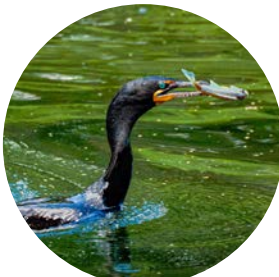
MOOSE

Maine is the only eastern state with a sizable moose population.



WHALES

Whales in this region include humpback, pilot, minke, and the massive finback species.



BIRDS

See common murres, puffins, razorbills, black guillemots, great cormorants, and roseate terns.



BALD EAGLE

Keep a lookout for one of Maine's 500 pairs of bald eagles flying between the oceanfront cliffs.

WEST COAST



HUMPBACK WHALES

The annual 6,000 mile migration of humpback whales is one of the longest of any mammal.



SEABIRDS

More than two million seabirds across 29 species nest along the west coasts of California, Oregon, and Washington.



BOTTLENOSE DOLPHINS

Bottlenose dolphins are extremely social animals that live in groups that can stay together for decades, mating, hunting, and protecting each other.



SEA LIONS

Sea lions spend most of their time in the water, but they go on land to mate, give birth, rest, and molt.

Itinerary 1

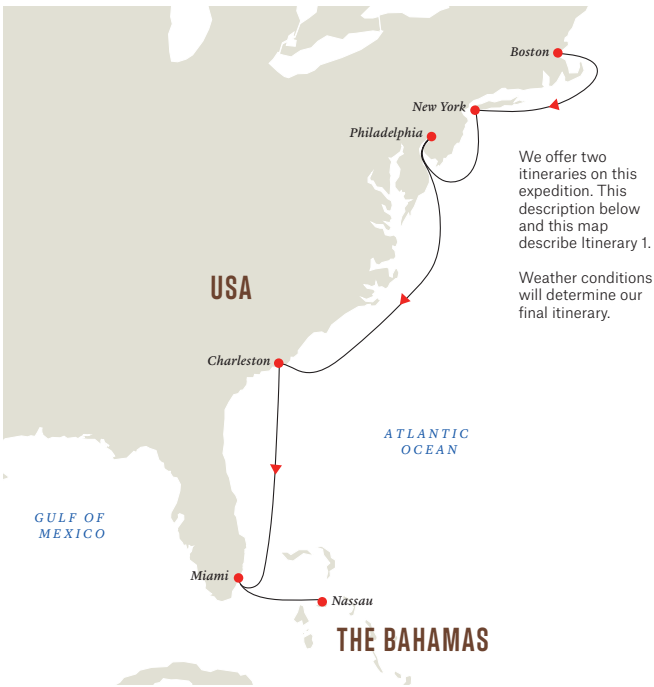
Discover the United States’ rich history on a voyage from Boston to New York and Philadelphia, and then explore the southern charm of Charleston and colorful Miami before disembarking in Nassau, in the Bahamas.

Day 1 Boston
Discover a treasure trove of authentic Americana in Boston, home to Harvard and such legendary sports teams as the Red Sox, Patriots, and Celtics. Walk the Freedom Trail and explore the revolutionary roots of the United States’ oldest city. Consider arriving a few days early and exploring more on a Pre-Program.

Days 2–3 New York City
(Overnight)
Sail past the iconic Statue of Liberty into Manhattan, where we dock overnight, and take a bite out of ‘the Big Apple.’ Marvel at the skyline of this incredible metropolis, stroll through Central Park, see a Broadway show, or admire the city lights from the top the

Empire State Building. Explore the city on your own or on one of our optional excursions.

Day 4 Philadelphia (Half day)
Discover one of America’s most historic cities, home to the Liberty Bell and Independence Hall, and where the U.S. Constitution was signed in 1787.

Itinerary 1

Sail south along North America’s Eastern Seaboard and experience culture, historic sites, dramatic scenery, and stunning autumn colors. Starting in Halifax, we cruise Maine’s magnificent coastline, visit Cape Cod, and overnight in Boston.

Day 1 Halifax
Your journey begins in Halifax, with its leafy parks, landmark Citadel Hill National Historic Site, and excellent museums. We suggest spending an extra day or two here on a Pre-Program before embarking on MS Roald Amundsen.

Day 2 Yarmouth (Full day)
Discover the mix of traditional Anglo-Scots and Acadian French cultures in this busy seaport with the largest fishing fleet in Atlantic Canada. Enjoy ocean views and hiking trails at the Cape Forchu Lighthouse.

Day 3 Eastport (Full day)
Stroll the downtown historic district of Eastport and visit shops,

restaurants, and cafés. Home to Native Americans for 10,000 years, the area is frequented by eagles, seals, and whales.

Experience the unique ambience of Bar Harbor, surrounded by spectacular Acadia National Park, which is simply stunning in the fall, and where you find the region’s best seafood restaurants.

U.S. West Coast – Highlights of the Pacific

Admire the rugged natural beauty of America’s West Coast as we sail north along California and Washington. Visit Santa Catalina Island, and enjoy late spring in legendary cities such as Santa Barbara, San Francisco, and Seattle.

Day 1 San Diego
Discover the beaches of laid-back San Diego, described as ‘America’s Finest City.’ We recommend booking a Pre-Program to explore more of what this city and its surroundings have to offer before embarking on MS Roald Amundsen.
