Raise Me is:

- A platform that allows high school students to earn micro-scholarships for their achievements in academics, community service, leadership, and student clubs.
- An easy way for students to see how their efforts pay off as early as 9th grade.

The Raise Me + Penn State Partnership:

- Allows students to earn scholarships that are directly applicable to Penn State without requiring additional applications or evaluations.
- Allows funds to be applied to students' financial aid awards when they enroll at Penn State.
- Encourages students to engage with Penn State early and see that Penn State recognizes and values their efforts.
- Reduces financial obstacles and debt upon graduation

Schools/Counselors Supporting Students:

- Introduce Raise Me and Penn State starting as early as 9th grade
- Invite students to the Raise Me platform, guide students in tracking achievements and earnings, and provide periodic reminders via the Raise Me platform.
- Connect students with Penn State representatives through school visits, university events, individual counseling sessions, and group workshops
- Celebrate milestones along the way
