

Good Earth Rechargeable Integrated Lights Recall June 6, 2024



June 6: The U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) and Good Earth Lighting Inc. are recalling over 1.2 million Good Earth Rechargeable Integrated Lights because the product can overheat and cause a fire. There's a report of one death and another six cases in which the lights overheated, resulting in fires and property damage.

Product(s) affected: Over 1.2 million Good Earth Rechargeable Integrated Lights sold from Oct. 2017 - Jan. 2024 at Ace Hardware, Lowe's, Meijer, and Menards and online on Amazon.com, GoodEarthLighting.com, Lowes.com, and QVC.

What to do if you have the product(s): Stop using the product immediately. Contact Good Earth for a free replacement (including shipping). You'll need to write the date and your initials next to the model number (on the back of the light) and the word "Recalled" on the front of the light.
