May 6: Aldi is recalling several varieties of their Happy Farms cream cheese, including Whipped Cream Cheese Spread, Cream Cheese Spread, Chive & Onion Cream Cheese Spread, and Strawberry Cream Cheese Spread, due to potential salmonella contamination.

Affected product(s): The affected products were sold at select Aldi locations in Alabama, Arizona, Arkansas, California, Delaware, the District of Columbia, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Kentucky, Maryland, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, New Jersey, New York, North Carolina, North Dakota, Ohio, Pennsylvania, South Carolina, South Dakota, Tennessee, Texas, Virginia, West Virginia, and Wisconsin.
