## Procter & Gamble (P&G) Laundry Pods Recall April 11, 2024



April 5: Procter & Gamble (P&G) is recalling 8.2 million bags of laundry pods because the packaging can split open (near the zipper), making the contents accessible to children and "vulnerable populations" which pose a risk of serious injury if the laundry pods or packets are ingested, and pose a risk for eye or skin injuries as well.

**Product(s) affected**: The following Tide Pods, Gain Flings, Ace, and Ariel laundry detergent packets sold at retailers nationwide, including Walmart. Target, Family Dollar, and online on Amazon.com and other websites between Sept. 2023 - Feb. 2024. Here's the full list of lot numbers.

P&G will also give you a prepaid debit card (equal to your purchase price), a replacement bag, and a cabinet latch to help you securely store your laundry products.
