

Toshiba Laptop AC Adapters Recall Feb. 21, 2024



Feb. 21: Importer, Dynabook Americas, has recalled about 15.5 million Toshiba Laptop AC Adapters because they can overheat and spark, posing burn and fire hazards.

Product(s) affected: Toshiba AC adapters sold with Toshiba brand laptops or sold separately between April 2008 - April 2014. [Recalled adapters will have date codes](#) between April 2008 - December 2012 in a year month, date format such as April 2008 is 0804, or a year week, date format, for example, week 15 of 2008 is 0815.

What to do if you have the product(s): Stop using immediately. Check your [model and serial numbers](#) to ensure your adapter is part of the recall. You'll have to submit a photo of your AC adapter with the power cord cut and certify that you'll dispose of the adapter properly.
