Oregon RN Licensing Program.

This program is limited to a select specialty group. You must receive a license promo invitation email directly from USN in order to qualify.

If you apply for a new nursing license or renewal in the state of Oregon between November 27 and December 20, 2024, USN will reimburse your license fees up to \$350.

You must obtain an active Permanent Oregon nursing license <u>AND</u> be submitted by USN to one of the Oregon specialty positions listed above in order to receive reimbursement.

Reimbursement and expenses paid includes the application fee, license verification and background check fees. USN will not reimburse for transcripts, postage, or coursework fees.

Qualified applicants will be reimbursed within 4-6 weeks upon proof of an ACTIVE Permanent verifiable online Oregon license. If you have never previously completed an assignment with Fastaff or USN, you must provide a W-9 IRS form along with your receipt.

For Home Health and Home Hospice nurses to qualify for reimbursement of their Oregon RN license, they must:

- 1. Have recent Home Health or Home Hospice experience within the past 2 years
- 2. Have recent experience and be proficient charting in Oasis
- 3. Have recently worked as a Home Health or Home Hospice nurse traveling to patient's home for care
- 4. Have a current/valid driver's license
- 5. Be comfortable and willing to drive to a patient's home during the upcoming potential strike (using a company provided vehicle)

All Oregon license receipts and W-9 forms must be emailed to USNLicensing@usnursing.com by Friday, December 20, 2024.

Reimbursements are paid out via live check. Ensure your correct mailing address appears on your USN / Ingenovis Health profile and include your correct address in the email with your receipts.
