ICBC 2021 REVENUE REQUIREMENTS APPLICATION

On December 15, 2020, the Insurance Corporation of British Columbia (ICBC) filed an application with the British Columbia Utilities Commission (BCUC) seeking approval for, among other things, a Universal Compulsory Automobile Insurance (Basic insurance) rate decrease of 15 percent for the policy year commencing May 1, 2021.

By Order G-12-21, the BCUC has approved ICBC's request on an interim basis. The BCUC has established an open and transparent public proceeding to review ICBC's revenue requirements application, which includes an opportunity for public comment and participation.

Any parties who wish to participate in the BCUC's regulatory review process are invited to register as interveners, interested parties or submit letters of comment. All submissions will be considered by the Panel in its review of the Application.
