Notes

It is an offence under section 230(1) of the Fisheries Act 1996 to make any false or misleading statement in this application. If you are convicted of an offence against that section, you are liable to a fine not exceeding \$250,000.

If the ownership of this vessel changes to such an extent that consent of the Director-General under section 103A(4) of the Fisheries Act 1996 is required, the operator must immediately notify the Director-General in writing and the registration of the vessel and any notified user registration will be cancelled immediately.

If any of the details relating to the registration of this vessel change, the operator must immediately notify the Director-General in writing.

The Commission for the Conservation of Southern Bluefin Tuna (CCSBT) has established a list of fishing vessels that are authorised to fish for Southern Bluefin Tuna. If you indicate on this form that Southern Bluefin Tuna will be caught on this vessel, the vessel will be added to the authorised list. This list is publicly available at www.ccsbt.org.

Fishing vessels that are not on the list are deemed by CCSBT not to be authorised to fish for, retain on board, tranship or land Southern Bluefin Tuna. Product from vessels that are not listed will not be able to be authorised for export as part of the Southern Bluefin Tuna trade information scheme. As such they will not be accepted as imported product by countries co-operating with CCSBT (most notably Japan).

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
