## MODIFICATION APPLICATION AND REPORT - WESTLINK KEMPS CREEK LOGISTICS PARK 290-308 ALDINGTON ROAD, 59-62 ABBOTTS ROAD AND 63 ABBOTTS ROAD, KEMPS CREEK

Dear Ms. Fishburn,

Thank you for providing Transport for NSW (**TfNSW**) an opportunity to provide advice in accordance with clause 2.35 of the State Environmental Planning Policy (Industry & Employment) 2021 on the above-mentioned state significant development (**SSD**) known as the Westlink Industrial Estate located at 290-308 Aldington Road, 59-62 Abbotts Road and 63 Abbotts Road, Kemps Creek. TfNSW advises that:

• The proposed modifications are minor in nature and do not propose any changes that significantly increase the traffic generation of the site, and the development remains generally consistent with the approved Concept Master Plan of the site (SSD-9138102).

As such, TfNSW advises that concurrence would be provided in accordance clause 2.35 of the *State Environmental Planning Policy (Industry & Employment) 2021* subject to the Department's approval and the following TfNSW conditions being included in any Development Consent issued:

## **Road Works**

To mitigate the traffic impacts of the proposed development and consistent with the LOG East package of roadworks that supported the approval of the concept masterplan, TfNSW requires that prior to occupation of the proposed warehouse the following components of the LOG East package of road works shall be completed:

- The signalised intersection of Mamre Road and Abbots Road.
- Abbotts Road widening between Mamre Road and Aldington Road.

## **Construction Traffic Management Plan**

To mitigate the impact of construction traffic, prior to the commencement of any works on-site (including demolition works) associated with any stage or prior to the issue of any Construction Certificate, whichever occurs first, a Construction Traffic Management Plan (CTMP) shall be submitted to Council and TfNSW for review and approval via development.ctmp.cjp@transport.nsw.gov.au.
