


Landscape Masterplan







Northern Boundary


The northern boundary will be planted with massed grassed and groundcovers. Canopy trees in groups will line the boundary with emphasis on screening around the adjacent heritage building.







Mass planting to tiered sandstone log walls






Plan Eastern Boundary


Sandstone log wall - see attached "Sandstone Log






Shrubs to screen upper walls Sandstone log retaining walls








Aldington Road Retaining Wall
