# Key to-do's for complying with the General Product Safety Regulations

To meet the requirements of the EU's General Product Safety Regulation (GPSR), effective December 13, 2024, have a look at this checklist which can help your business and products to comply.

### 1. Include manufacturer information

Display the **manufacturer's name**, **registered trade name or trademark**, and **postal address** on your product listings.

Add **electronic contact details** like an email address or website.

If the manufacturer is outside the EU, provide details for the **responsible person within the EU**.

### 2. Ensure clear product identification

Provide clear **product images**, **type designations**, or **other identifiers** for each product.

Make it easy for consumers and authorities to identify your products.

### 3. Add warnings and safety information

Include any **mandatory warnings or safety instructions** in the product listing.

Present information in the **local language(s)** of your target market.

Ensure safety details are clear and easy to understand.

### 4. Understand risk assessments and documentation requirements

Be aware that **risk assessments** are a crucial part of the legal requirements under product safety regulations.

These assessments help evaluate potential safety risks associated with your products.

The law also requires maintaining **technical documentation** for products, ensuring it is up-to-date and kept for at least **10 years**.

It is the responsibility of your business to ensure these steps are implemented in accordance with the regulations, thereby reducing liability risks.

### 5. Implement an incident reporting system

Set up a process to quickly **report accidents or safety issues** to the authorities.

Keep records of incidents and take corrective actions when needed.

### 6. Ensure product traceability

Develop a system to **track your products** through the supply chain.

Ensure you can identify components and involved parties in case of safety concerns.

### 7. Cooperate with authorities

Be prepared to provide product details or access to documentation if requested by market surveillance authorities.
