We reserve the right to reject a proposal before assessment if your application is: not clear and concise; has an obvious lack of content/evidence; or does not provide any clear, meaningful response to the application requirements.

For each proposal, a panel of assessors score against the criteria, and a moderator from the collaborating organisation will make any final decisions on disputes between which companies are appropriate to join the activity.

We're looking for clear evidence that you have understood the aim of the workshop.

Likelihood to benefit from the workshop

We are interested in those that can both learn from the content of the workshop, as well as contribute useful insight and experience to the broader discussion. We are also looking for those that can progress their learning following the workshop.

Relevant industry experience

We are interested in applications from those who have relevant industry experience to the industry being addressed. We will also consider appropriate cross industry knowledge and learning that can be applied from other sectors.

Expertise in the appropriate technology area

We are looking for applications from experts that have expertise and experience in appropriate technology areas. We are interested in those that can bring new cutting edge ideas into discussions.
