


From Calicut Chapter (Mikavu)



The alumni of the 1981 outgoing batch have established the "1981 NSS Engineers' Scholarship Trust (NEST '81)" with a shared commitment to give back to their alma mater. The batch commenced their academic journey in October 1976 and graduated in March 1981. Since 1990, they have consistently held annual reunions, with the latest gathering organized in February 2025 at Malampuzha. As part of the event, the alumni visited the campus and felicitated former Principals and faculty members in recognition of their invaluable guidance. Driven by a spirit of gratitude and social responsibility, the batch collectively resolved to support deserving students of the institution. The Trust aims to provide financial assistance to academically outstanding students. Students already receiving scholarships or financial aid will not be eligible, ensuring support reaches the most deserving. The selection and distribution process is being undertaken with the College authorities and College Alumni Association, ensuring transparency and integrity in all procedures.

A dedicated corpus fund has been created through contributions from the 1981 batch members. The first scholarships was distributed in a function held at College on 17th December 2025. This year the scholarship was awarded to 12 students, each receiving ₹15,000.
