

The Castleton to Rochdale Active Travel Route – Phase 2



Phase 2 – Quiet Streets

- More greenery
- Opportunities for public to help plant landscaped areas
- Improved footpath materials to improve the public realm and comfort for people walking
- Road re-surfacing
- 20mph speed limits and traffic calming measures
- Improved signs and road markings for cyclists
- Benches
- Bike pumps for public use

Phase 2

- Two way segregated cycle lane
- New footpath, cycleway and road surfacing
- Infill of existing subway
- Improved road crossing for pedestrians and cyclists at Kemp Avenue and New Barn Lane to replace existing subway connection

Phase 2

- New two way cycle lane with segregation and surfacing

Phase 2 – Junction and crossing upgrades

- 1 Manchester Road/Bolton Road
- 2 Manchester Road/Montgomery Street crossing
- 3 Manchester Road/Roch Valley Way
- 4 Manchester Road/New Barn Lane
- 5 Manchester Road/Kemp Avenue
- 6 Manchester Road/Tweeddale Street
- 7 Manchester Road/Drake Street

Phase 2

- Segregated cycle lanes on each side of road
- New footway, cycleway and road surfacing

Phase 1

Currently on site and is due to finish October 2023

- Segregated cycle lanes on each side of road
- Road re-surfacing
- Two junction upgrades to include new walking and cycle crossings:
 - to regulate motor traffic movements
 - to provide controlled walking and cycling crossings
- Two independent push button road crossings for pedestrians and cyclists
- New footpath, cycle lanes and road re-surfacing
- Two new car parks
- Community play park on land opposite Abbott Street
