• A lot of people using bikes.




But we still need to do more by planning for:

What could transport look like in 2040?

Travelling to other countries and sending goods abroad

By 2040 we would like:



- To travel to Manchester Airport quicker and be using public transport.
- More ships to use Manchester Ship Canal to send goods.



More jobs in warehouses near Manchester
 Ship Canal and at Manchester Airport.



Travelling to other big cities such as London, Leeds and Liverpool

By 2040 we would like:



- Faster public transport to other big cities.
- Faster driving times on motorways.



• More jobs near new railway stations.

Travelling in and around Manchester city centre By 2040 we would like:



More new jobs and homes in Manchester city centre and other central places like Salford Quays.



More people using public transport, cycling and walking.



• An all in one ticket to travel on trains, trams and buses.



Travelling across the rest of Greater Manchester

By 2040 we would like:

Town centres across Greater Manchester to have good shopping, more visitors and more people living there.





- People to use public transport, walk or cycle to town centres across Greater Manchester.
- Fewer people having a car and choosing to share if needed.
- New buildings and houses to be built in a good public transport area.



Travelling around our local area

By 2040 we would like:



- Safer local places to walk and cycle.
- Fewer people having a car and choosing to share if needed.



How are we going to do this by 2040?

We will need to:

- Build more transport such as rail lines and bus stations.
- Ensure roads and motorways run smoothly.
- Work well with other groups in Greater Manchester.
