Gates will open 2 hours before match start.

The following information will help you plan your travel to Old Trafford and offers transport tips to help make your visit as enjoyable as possible.

- Plan both onward and return journeys well in advance and remember that you can purchase you train tickets up to 90 days in advance.
- Allow enough time for your journey and get here early as the venue can get extremely busy nearer to the start of the match.
- If you plan to travel by car, please also check www.trafficengland.com to make sure the planned roadworks do not affect your planned route.

Old Trafford is located in the borough of Trafford, 3 miles from Manchester city centre and is well connected by local tram and bus services. It also has a number of car parks located within walking distance to the ground and blue badge parking available at the ground.

GETTING TO OLD TRAFFORD



... BY TRAM

Old Trafford tram station is located right beside the cricket ground and provides the easiest and most direct link.

Journeys take around 15 minutes from Manchester city centre with three stops within easy walking distance of the ground:

- Old Trafford
- Trafford Bar
- Exchange Quay

On match day Metrolink provide extra support staff and additional services to coincide with the start and finish times. Tram services to Old Trafford will provide direct links to Manchester Piccadilly Station and Manchester Victoria Station.

You must have a valid ticket before you board a tram. Please be aware that ticket checks take place across the network. For the latest timetable information please visit Transport for Greater Manchester.



... BY BUS

Currently, the 53, 79, 250, 255, 256, 263 and x50 services all run within 5 minutes walk to Old Trafford.

... BY CAR - PARK & RIDE

Recommended Park & Ride sites are as follows:

- Sale Water Park
- 300 spaces + 16 Blue Badge spaces
- Easy Access off the M60
- Rifle Road, Sale, M33 2LX
- 12 minutes from Sale Water Park to Trafford Bar Station and then a 10 minute walk to the ground.
- Ladywell
- 250 spaces
- Eccles New Road, Eccles, M6 8HD
- 30 minutes from Ladywell to Old Trafford.

... BY TRAIN

If travelling to Manchester by train, we recommend arriving into Manchester Piccadilly Station or Manchester Victoria Station and connect onto a Metrolink service to Old Trafford.

If you're travelling into the city centre by train, you can purchase a Metrolink add-on to your train ticket allowing onward travel to the stadium by tram. Plan your **journey here**.



... BY CAR - VENUE PARKING

There is no match day parking at Old Trafford cricket ground. The official event car park is located at Old Trafford football ground. Vehicles will be directed to N3 – The North Car Park – which is located off Wharfside Way.



... ACTIVE TRAVEL

WALK If you are local to the area, walking is a great way to get around. World Cup Cricketeers will be along the route to help answer any questions and guide you to the ground! Have a look at the Spectator Venue Guide to find the guickest route.



CYCLE If you chose to cycle to the match there are cycle racks at Trafford Town Hall. There is no cycle parking at the ground.
