

**You can only apply for one category, either if you have walking difficulties
OR if you would be refused a driving licence.**

Eligibility criteria if you have walking difficulties

The applicant is permanently resident in Greater Manchester and has serious walking difficulties. This means being unable to walk 100m (110 yards) without stopping, severe discomfort or help from another person.

Do you receive?

- Higher rate mobility component of Disabled Living Allowance; or
- PIP (Personal Independence Payment) – the award must be for at least 8 points or above in the “moving around” activity; or
- War Pensioner’s Mobility Supplement.

- Yes – please send the letter (dated within the last 12 months and showing the same address as overleaf) which provides this information.
- No – Transport for Greater Manchester will send you a questionnaire. When this is completed and returned, it will be assessed by Transport for Greater Manchester’s medical advisor. You may be asked to attend a brief assessment.

Eligibility criteria if you would be refused a driving licence

The applicant would, if they applied for a driving licence under Part 111 of the Road Traffic Act 1988, have their application refused pursuant to section 92 of the Act (physical fitness) for reasons other than on the grounds of persistent misuse of drugs or alcohol.
