
Information on the Park and Ride Service

What is the Park and Ride Service?

The Park and Ride service is specifically designed for Manchester City supporters who wish to travel to the Etihad Stadium for all men's team home games, without having the hassle of having to drive all the way to the Etihad Stadium. The Park and Ride will allow supporters to park at Booth Street West Car Park and hop on the shuttle bus to Connell College. This will be in place for all remaining fixtures from 12th April 2025.

What is the time and frequency of the PnR service from Booth Street West Car Park to the Etihad?

There will be just one departure, departing one hour prior to kick off, therefore the shuttle bus is sold on a first come basis.

Am I buying a seat on the bus?

No, buying a ticket doesn't reserve a seat, it buys a space on the bus, buses in Greater Manchester have standing and seated capacity.

How much does the Matchday Bus service cost?

£6 per car, with a maximum of 4 people, any above will have to pay £4 adult return, £2 child return.

Where does the PnR service pick up?

The service will pick up on Higher Cambridge Street, at the bus stop opposite Booth Street West Car Park D, outside Trinity High School.

And Where does it drop off?

The drop off point is at Connell College, on Alan Turing Way, around 10 minute walk to the south stand of the Etihad.

Where will the bus be after the match?

The service will depart from Connell College, the same place you got dropped off. To give supporters time to get back, the bus will depart 25 mins after final whistle.

Will the PnR bus run every game?

Yes, the PnR service will be on for all remaining men's fixtures for the 24/25 season.

How often does it run?

One bus will operate and take supporters to the ground on a designated timetable, based on the kick-off time for each fixture, departing one hour prior to kick off. The same bus will be there after the match to take supporters back to Booth Street West Car Park D, departing 25 mins after final whistle.

How do I pay?

You can pay for your car parking and bus travel at mancity.com

What do I do when at the car park?

On arrival at the car park, press the button on the machine to obtain a ticket.

Once parked, visit the Attendants lodge on the ground floor of the car park, with the ticket and your car park booking information, and your ticket will be validated for exit.

Keep the ticket safe, it will be needed to exit on your return to the car park.

On exit, enter your validated ticket into the machine at the barrier, and the barrier will open

Staff will be present, should you have any issues.

What are my options if I want to park, but don't want to travel on the dedicated bus?

There are several options, you can choose to walk to the Etihad, which is just over 2 miles away and will take about 40 mins. Or you can walk to St Peters Square, 1 mile away, and catch a tram direct to the Etihad Campus. Alternatively you can jump on a bus from Oxford Road to Piccadilly, then catch a dedicated Etihad service.

Who manages the Bus service?

The bus service is operated and managed by Transport for Greater Manchester on behalf of Manchester City.
