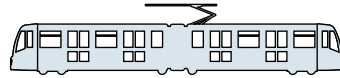

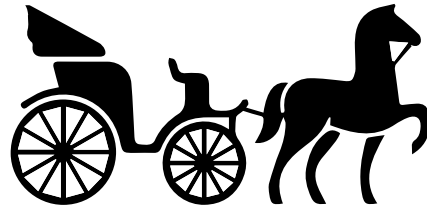

The invention of the car meant horses stopped being the main way to travel.

Some travel inventions being tested now are:

- Autonomous cars
 - cars which drive themselves
- Elevated cycle paths
 - roads just for bikes that are built above houses
- Super trains
 - trains which travel four times as fast as current trains

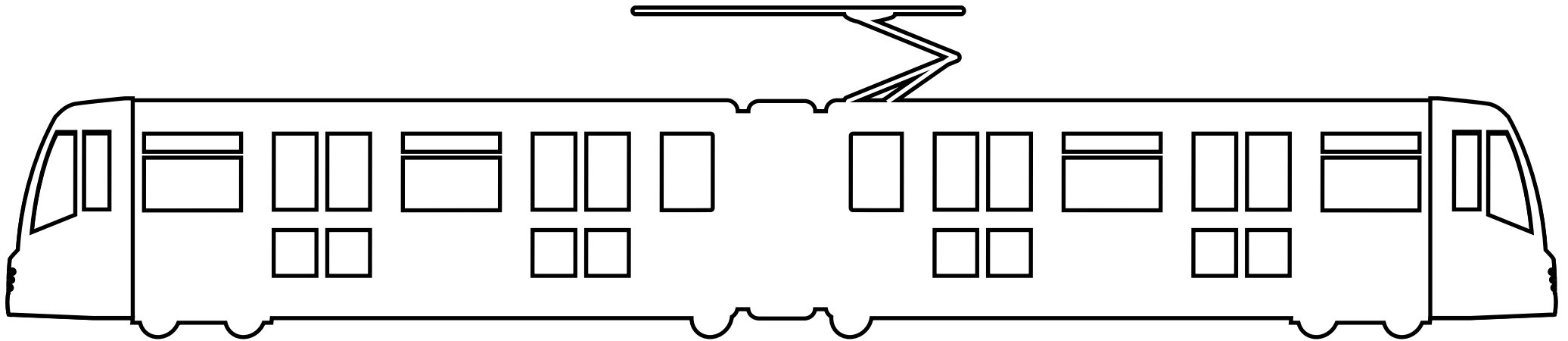
