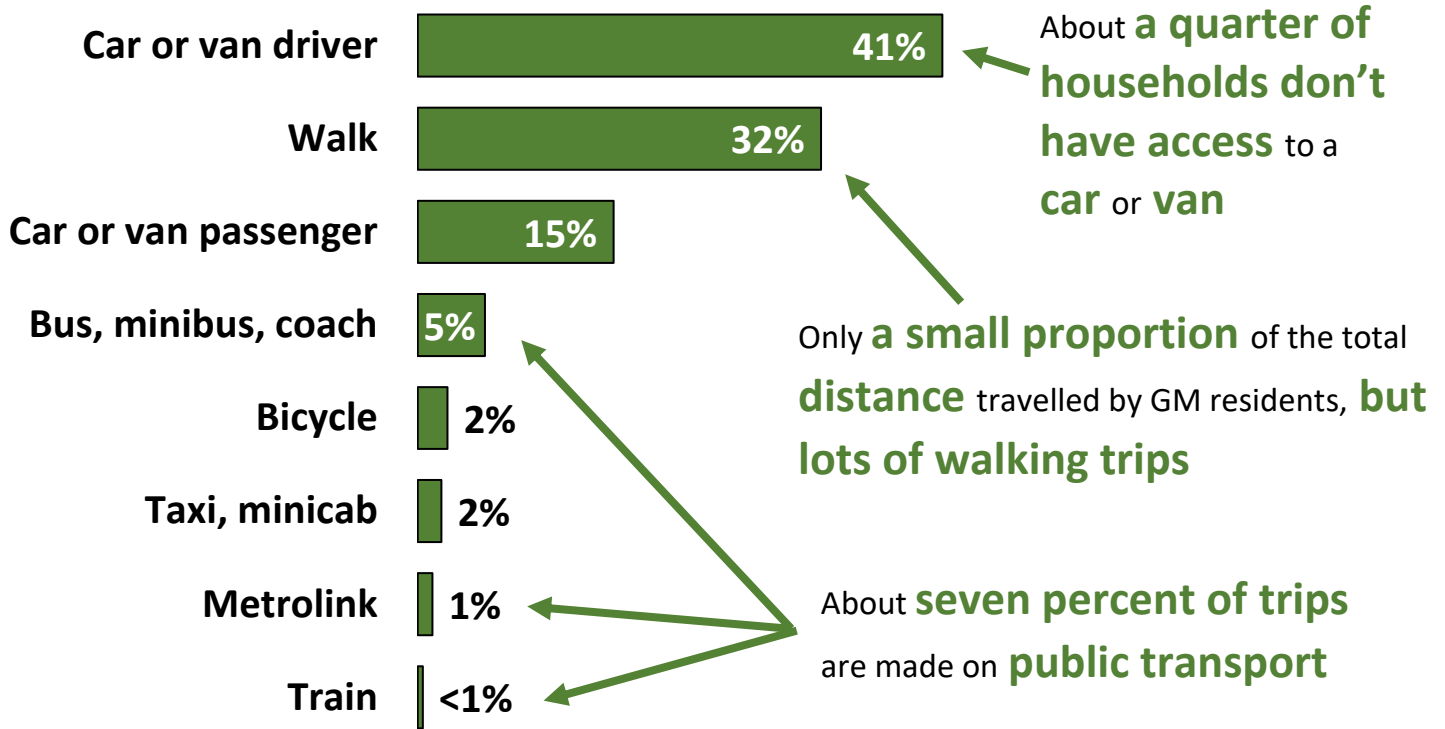


Great Manchester Travel Diary Survey 2021 – summary

Greater Manchester (GM) residents make **an average of 1.6 trips per day**, which is about **4.1 million trips per day** or **1.5 billion trips per year!** On any given day in 2021, **two-fifths** of GM residents **didn't make any trips**.

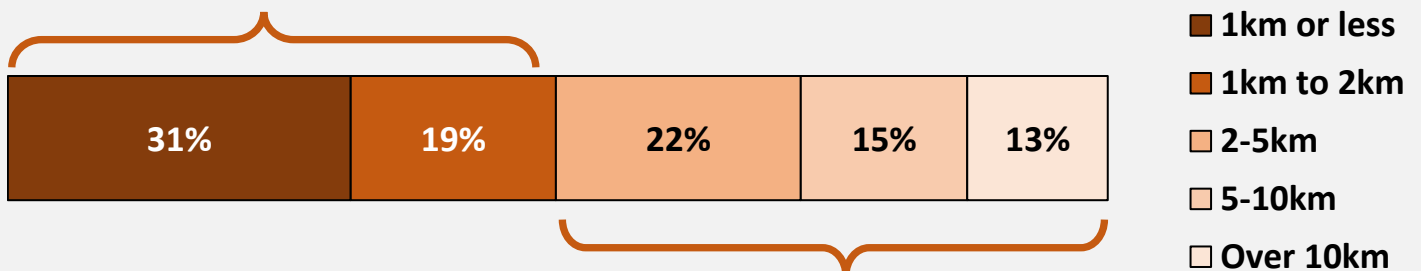
% of trips by main mode



40% of **households** have an **annual income** of **less than £20,000** and they make **43%** of their **trips** in a **car or van**, while **households** with an **annual income** of **£20,000 or more** make **61%** of their **trips** in a **car or van**.

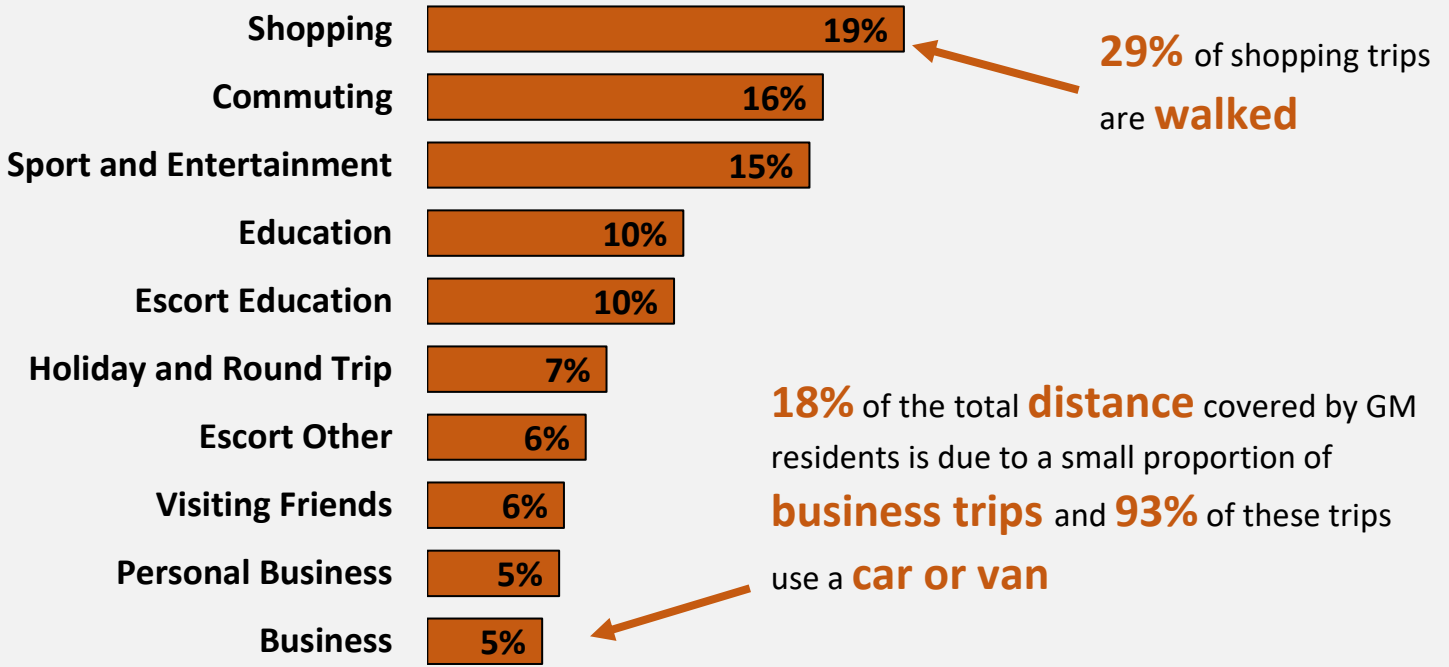
Distance travelled

58% of **short trips** are **walked**



For **78%** of **longer trips** the main mode of transport is a **car or van**

Journey purpose

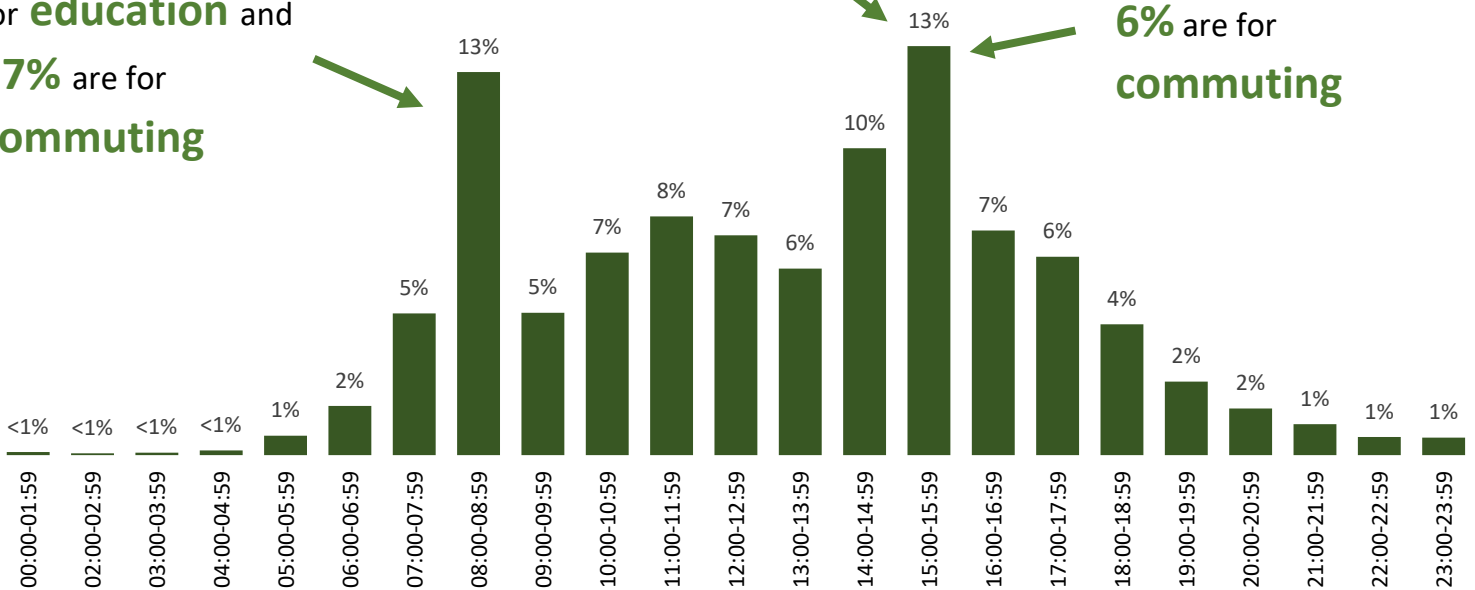


Trip start time

65% of these trips are for education and 17% are for commuting

About 40% of these trips are walked

54% of these trips are for education and 6% are for commuting



81% of shopping trips start between 10:00 and 15:59

95% of all trips start between 07:00 and 21:59
