
Information on the Rail Station Services

What is the Rail Station Service?

The Rail Station services are specifically designed for Manchester City supporters who wish to travel to the Etihad Stadium for all men's team home games, connecting rail journey with onward travel to the Etihad.

What is the time and frequency of the rail services from Piccadilly and Victoria to the Etihad?

There will be just one departure from each of the rail stations, departing one hour prior to kick off, operating on a first come basis.

How much does the Rail Station service cost?

£4 adult return, £2 child return and free of charge for those in possession of a concessionary pass.

Where does the Rail Station service pick up?

The Piccadilly Rail service will pick up on Fairfield Street, at the bus stop close to the station taxi rank.

The Victoria Rail service will pick up on Corporation Street, at the bus stop close to National Football Museum.

And Where does it drop off?

Both services will drop off on Ashton New Road, at the stop close to Tesla garage, behind the South Stand.

Where will the bus be after the match?

Both services will depart from Ashton New Road, close to the junction with Darley Street. Bus will depart 25 mins after final whistle.

Will the rail services run every game?

Yes, both rail service will be on for all remaining men's fixtures for the 24/25 season.

How often does it run?

One bus will operate and take supporters to the ground on a designated timetable, based on the kick-off time for each fixture, departing one hour prior to kick off. The same bus will be there after the match to take supporters back to the rail stations, departing 25 mins after final whistle.

How do I pay?

You prepurchase your travel through mancity.com.

Who manages the Bus service?

The bus service is operated and managed by Transport for Greater Manchester on behalf of Manchester City.
