Trafford Borough Council acting as the local Highway Authority approves the permit scheme referred to as 'The Greater Manchester Permit Scheme' and in exercise of its powers conferred by section 33A (2) of the Traffic Management Act 2004 makes this order:-The Order may be cited as the as The Traffic Management (Trafford Borough Council) Permit Scheme Amendment Order 2015 and shall come into force on 1 October 2015

- the Greater Manchester Road Activities Permit Scheme which came into effect on 29 April
 2013 under the Traffic Management (Trafford Borough Council) Permit Scheme Order 2013 is
 varied to comply with the Traffic Management Permit Scheme (England) Regulations 2007 as
 amended by the Traffic Management Permit Scheme (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2015
- 2. Acting as the local highway authority for all roads in the Borough of Trafford Borough Council approves the Greater Manchester Road Activities Permit Scheme which is set out in the Schedule to this Order
- 3. The Greater Manchester Road Activities Permit Scheme set out in the Schedule to this Order complies with all aspects of the Traffic Management Permit Scheme (England) Regulations 2007 as amended by the Traffic Management Permit Scheme (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2015, with all other primary and secondary legislation in relation to Traffic Management Permit Schemes, and does not exceed the powers provided under such legislation.
- 4. Part 8 of the Traffic Management Permit Scheme (England) Regulations 2007 shall apply to the specified streets within the Greater Manchester Road Activities Permit Scheme.

Commencement of Permit Scheme

The Greater Manchester Road Activities Permit Scheme comes into effect on 1 October 2015
