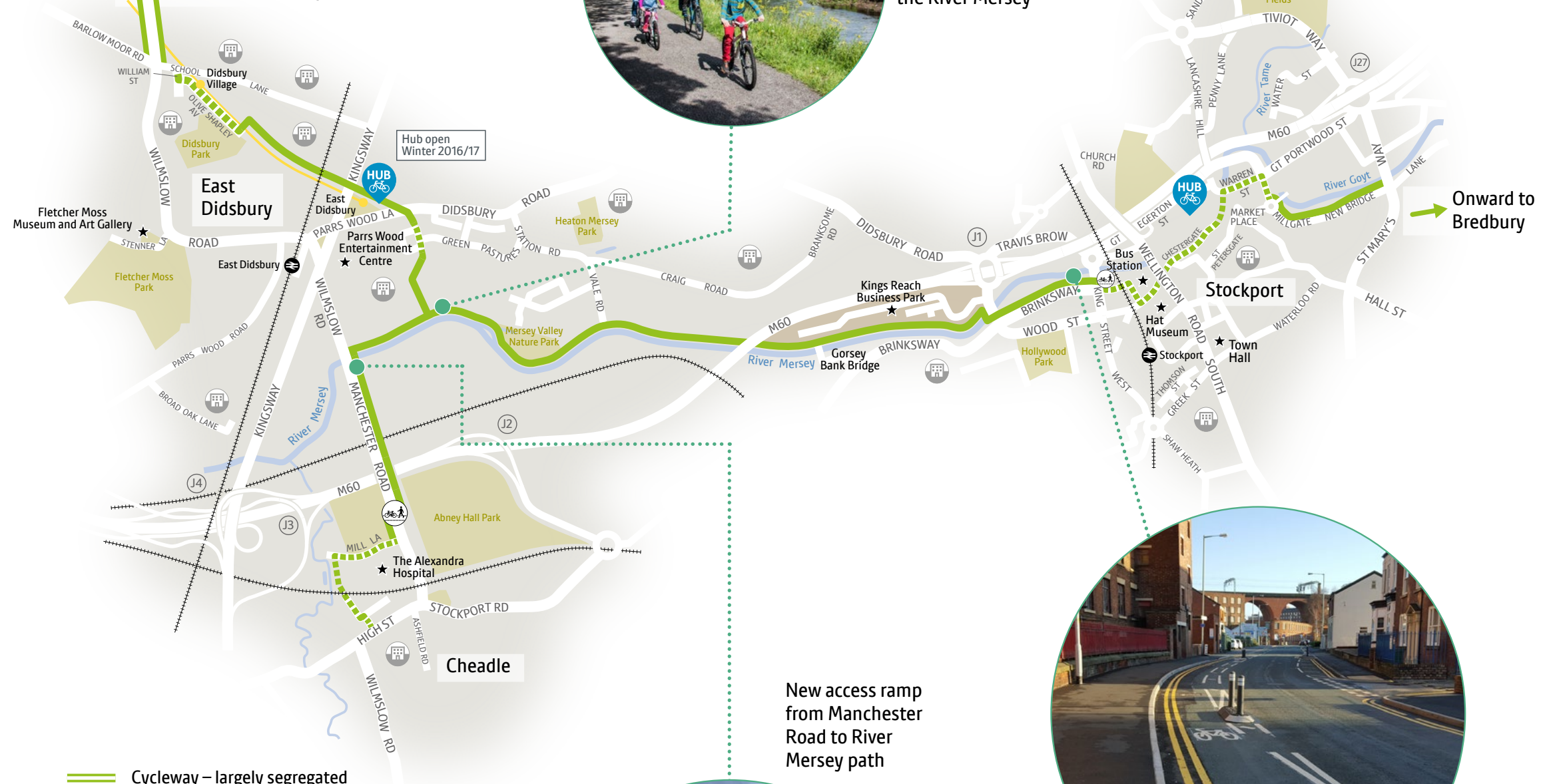

Mersey Valley and Stockport Cycleway takes you on a green riverside route that links Stockport town centre with Cheadle and Didsbury. Here you can pick up Wilmslow Road Cycleway, bringing you all the way to Rusholme and the universities.

Most of the route is traffic-free, and some sections are on roads where the cycle lane is separated from other traffic.
