Easy access on buses



All buses have no steps at the entrance, making getting on and off easier. Low floor buses have a ramp for access and a dedicated space for wheelchairs and pushchairs inside the bus. Ask the driver for any assistance you require.

Using this timetable

Timetables show the direction of travel, bus numbers and the days of the week. Main stops on the route are listed on the left. Where no time is shown against a particular stop, it means the bus does not stop there on that journey.

Check any letters which are shown in the timetable against the key at the bottom of the page.



- The map illustrates the path of bus route 440, starting at Syke and ending in Rochdale. The route is marked with a thick black line. Key locations and streets along the way include:

 - Syke**: Starting point, near Chapel.
 - Dewhurst Road**: The route follows this road through Syke.
 - Fieldhouse Road**: The route turns onto this road.
 - Mizzi Road**: The route continues along this road.
 - Whitehall Street**: The route turns onto this street, passing the **Rochdale Infirmary**.
 - Howard Street**: The route turns onto this street.
 - Whitworth Road**: The route turns onto this road.
 - St Mary's Gate**: The route turns onto this street.
 - John Street**: The route turns onto this street.
 - Molesworth Street**: The route turns onto this street.
 - Rochdale**: The route ends in Rochdale, near **Water Street** and **Trams to Manchester**.

Other features include a **Metrolink stop** at **Rochdale Town Centre** and a **Tram line** running parallel to the bus route in the Rochdale area. The number **440** is shown in a box at the terminus in Rochdale.
