**Elanco, United Way Worldwide Announce Global Partnership to
“Break the Cycle of Hunger in 100 Communities”**

Greenfield, Ind. – In recognition of World Hunger Day 2016 (May 28th), Elanco Animal Health, a division of Eli Lilly and Company (LLY), and United Way Worldwide announce a strategic partnership to address global hunger/food security. Elanco is committing \$300,000 to “Break the Cycle of Hunger” in 100 Communities by 2020.

Currently this effort has been implemented in 62 communities in 18 countries impacting over 650,000 households. Examples of some of these communities include:

- Copperbelt, Zambia – helping more than 12,000 families increase their food security and incomes through sustainable livestock farming ([Heifer International](#))
