Zoning:	I-1 - Historical data center use
Equipment Yard:	Secured equipment area with expansion capacity on site



Details

Generators:	Two (2) 750 kVA Caterpillar generators
Fuel Storage:	Belly tanks on each generator -2,500 gallon and 1,600 gallon
Cooling:	Seven (7) Liebert CRAC Units including three (3) newer DS units
Data Center Area:	Overhead distribution and raised floor
On-Site Power:	Two pad-mounted transformer delivering 2000 amp, 277/480 volt service
Power Provider:	Duke Energy - Power fed to the site from two substations
Power Expansion:	Expansion to 6 MW within 33 weeks and up to 18 MW in 18 months
Security:	24x7 monitored security cameras and card access
Fire Protection:	Clean agent and VESDA pre-action zoned fire protection
Fiber:	Dual fiber entrances with diverse internal distribution capabilities. Numerous on-site metro and long haul fiber providers

Tax Incentives



The State of Florida offers a data center Sales Tax Exemption Incentive Program for data centers that locate or expand in Florida.

The exemption eliminates sales and use tax for data centers, infrastructure, equipment, personal property and electricity subject to meeting certain qualifications for projects completed by June 30, 2027.
