In the last year, people across 14 states lost access to abortion care in their communities entirely, and many others face new and harsh restrictions that make it nearly impossible to obtain this critical health care service. In response, carafem expanded our presence from 12 to 17 states and we're seeing a growing number of people traveling across state lines to quickly access abortion in our health centers and via telehealth. carafem has become the largest non-profit provider of trusted telehealth abortion services in the U.S., ensuring that individuals have options to access care remotely, 24 hours a day and seven days per week. We have successfully balanced in-person and at-home care at scale, offering comprehensive options to meet the diverse needs of our clients.

Drawing upon global best practices and our commitment to innovation, carafem actively worked towards expanding access to medication abortion. Understanding the potential threat of a ban on mifepristone, we paved the way for the seamless provision of misoprostol alone, thereby securing ongoing access to safe and legal abortion options with medication. This proactive approach aligns with our unwavering dedication to maintaining and improving access to reproductive healthcare services in the face of ever-changing legal landscapes.

Looking ahead, we recognize carafem's role in safeguarding and enhancing access to abortion care is more critical than ever before. carafem: The Leader in Personalized Abortion Care

carafem, founded in 2013, is a leader in providing medically supported at-home abortion care in 16 states and growing. We also offer in-person medical care including procedural abortion options, birth control, and STI testing and treatment in our offices in Atlanta, D.C., and the Chicago metro areas.

carafem provides care that is personalized and delivered in the way each client prefers — from inside our offices to scheduled video visits, or through 24/7 access to care with an Immediate Evaluation online that is available in just a few taps.

Equity and accessibility are cornerstones of our care, which is why carafem accepts Medicaid via telehealth and in health centers, provides care at low costs (\$0–249) for online care, and partners with national and local funding groups to lower costs and further offset travel and child care costs.



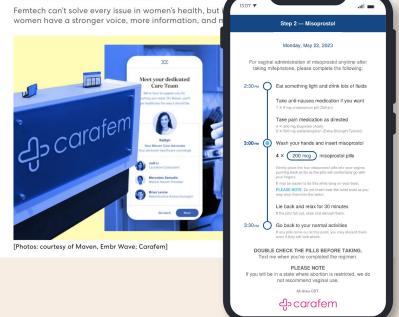

Technology Connects Clients and Care 24/7

Since launching Cara, carafem's text-based virtual assistant available 24x7, it has accompanied over 22,800 clients in their personal abortion care plans at home. Cara was named by Fast Company as a top three advancement in femtech in 2023. Most importantly, carafem's clients have found Cara to be helpful in their at-home abortion care, as shared in the quotes below:

"I think the reminders were also really nice because they were so personalized. She sent a picture with the time that I was supposed to take my medicine, which is super personalized to you. And I think that's really helpful. She communicated and gave a visual. And it felt like a real person since that is how we communicate all day, we send each other pictures..."

"I would describe 'Cara' as your personal friend while you're going through the time that you're going through. It's someone that's there for you. You can ask anything. If you're nervous, if you want to back out, if you need help... you can talk to someone."



Participation in Research Drives Innovation

Understanding that mifepristone is vulnerable to threats based in politics — not science — carafem developed a misoprostol alone protocol in 2020 and has provided this care to over 2,500 clients. carafem's protocol for misoprostol alone has a 95% efficacy rate.

This protocol was published in the medical journal, Contraception, in February 2023 and carafem helped train providers across the country on how to use this protocol effectively in case mifepristone is banned nationwide.

Throughout the *Alliance for Hippocratic Medicine v. FDA* case, carafem was called upon by allies and the media to share this evidence-based solution

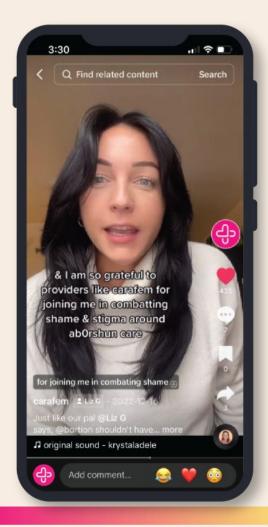

Communications Engage and Destigmatize

carafem launched its TikTok account in 2022 and has since received over seven million views of our content. By leveraging memes and collaborating with authentic and popular creators, carafem has been able to break through the noise and normalize reproductive health care conversations. A recent study titled, "<u>Medication abortion on TikTok: misinformation or reliable</u> <u>resource?</u>" published in the American Journal of Obstetrics & Gynecology affirms carafem's work as an important voice in this space.

carafem in the News

carafem works to reduce stigma in traditional media outlets as well, aiming to reach the general public but also improve search results, so clients can more easily find and access high quality care.

In 2022, carafem was mentioned in nearly 3,000 articles with a total potential reach of 9.6 billion impressions — a 600% increase over the prior year.

In addition, carafem received recognition for high-quality care from Verywell Health and Health.com, naming carafem the "most comprehensive" and "best user experience" among telehealth abortion providers.

Client satisfaction: Our most important indicator

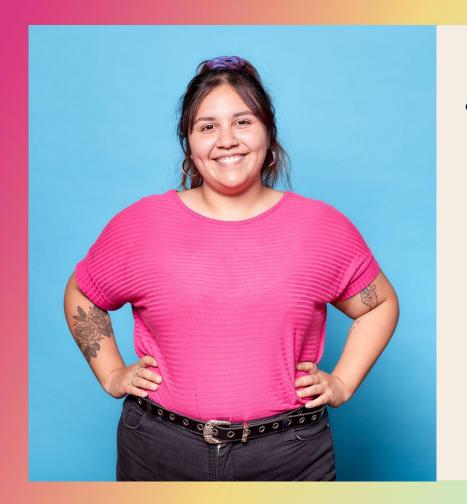

Who we served: carafem's client demographics in 2022



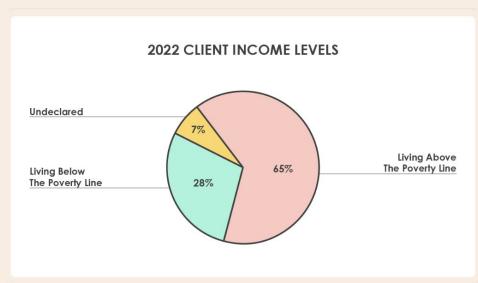


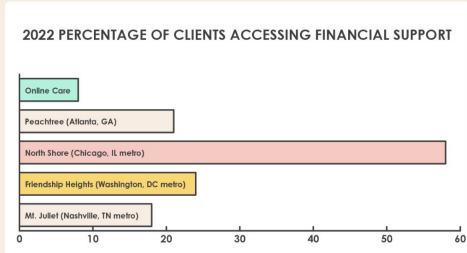




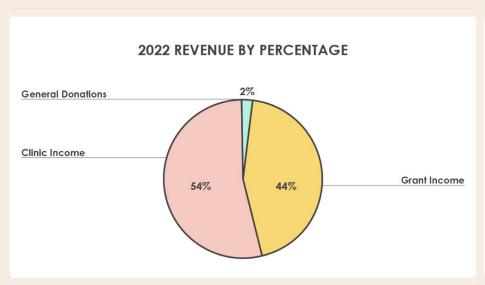


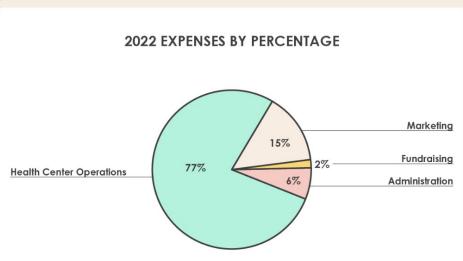
Who we served: carafem's client demographics in 2022
