

A Year of Innovation in the Face of Adversity

In an ever-changing world, and in spite of a global pandemic, one thing remains constant: people need access to abortion care. Over the last year, carafem persevered, adapted, and innovated to deliver high quality abortion care when people needed it most.

carafem saw remarkable growth in 2020, with a 50% increase in clients served over prior year. This increase came primarily from clients seeking care online through our new telehealth abortion care platform, the expansion of our Nashville health center to include in-office abortion procedures, and increased demand in our Chicago area health center for those using Illinois Medicaid as their payment source.

All carafem centers remained open during the COVID crisis to meet client needs in the many communities we serve. **carafem's** unique model of care proved to be "pandemic proof," as we see one client at a time, ensuring the safety and privacy of one-on-one time with a provider, and limited contact with other clients during visits.

Much of 2020's growth came from our telehealth abortion care platform. We provide private, convenient online medication abortion visits with a **carafem** clinician to our clients at home through a secure encrypted video conferencing platform. Over 900 discrete packages of medication abortion pills were shipped to **carafem** clients in Illinois, Maryland, Georgia, Virginia, and the District of Columbia just last year. **The majority of these clients were served in the final quarter of 2020 during which time we had streamlined our service delivery to more effectively reach more clients, particularly in rural areas across the country, than ever before. In light of our success, we plan to expand this service to as many clients as we can across the country.**

2020 also was a year where the world, including the field of reproductive health, has confronted issues of systematic racism. carafem has committed to ensuring we do not perpetuate the legacy of harm that has been part of the history of reproductive health. To that end, carafem affirmed that Black Lives Matter and committed to fight for racial justice — we published a Black Lives Matter statement on June 5th, and convened an internal Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI) Advisory Team. We commit together to deep reflection and action to understand how we enact racism and to take deliberate steps to dismantle it.

The past year has been one of innovation in the face of adversity. Next year will be focused on using our insights and technological advancements to expand virtual care to as many states as possible to reinforce our mission; increase access to compassionate and convenient reproductive healthcare. We look forward to serving many more clients in the coming year. carafem's success would not be possible without the enthusiastic work of the carafem team, donors, and volunteers. 
carafem works to center the client experience in justice, equity, diversity and inclusion.







carafem creates a high-quality, personalized medical experience for people of all income levels.

The cost of abortion care can push it out of reach for many, which is why carafem sets prices for all services at or below the local community's average cost and raises funds to cover the remaining costs. We partner with the National Abortion Federation and local funding entities to offer discounts to all clients who qualify because we are here to create the best medical experience for everyone, of all income levels. carafem also accepts private insurance and Medicaid, collaborates and provides direct discounts to clients who qualify.

While many other providers are unable to accept Medicaid or insurance for abortion care, carafem has worked with legal and advocacy partners to push through volumes of unpaid and delayed claims. We've also increased outreach and communications to reach people who need care and wish to use state Medicaid to fully cover the cost of their abortion care.

In 2020, the following percent of clients in each state accessed Medicaid for abortion care:









Nearly 15% of all carafem clients travel more than 100 miles for abortion care. carafem is working to plan for the needs of clients by expanding telemedicine and mailing abortion pills to clients who qualify.




carafem provides medical support at home, every step of the way.

carafem introduced "Cara," a text-based support system that helps clients manage their personalized care plan and get answers at any time without having to make awkward telephone calls.

When a client has a question that requires a medical professional, Cara can seamlessly connect them to a member of their care team for accurate timely answers.

We often hear feedback about how much clients love this tool, which greatly reduces their anxiety while they manage their abortion at home.

carafem's participation in research studies builds the body of evidence to improve access to abortion care.

Between March 2018 and December 2019, carafem participated in a study conducted by independent researchers at Ibis Reproductive Health to evaluate our client's perception of care. These results compared telehealth and in-person client satisfaction at our Atlanta health center.

According to the report, "survey responses indicate that, regardless of service delivery model, carafem clients had extremely positive experiences receiving abortion services. Given the high levels of satisfaction among telehealth clients, carafem clinics and staff should look for ways to expand and improve telehealth services." 
