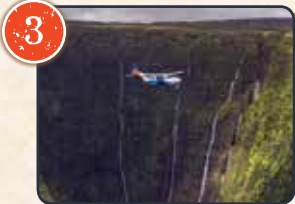
1 Big Island Spectacular

Discover both the Big Island's beauty and its volcanic fury. Tour the most geologically active environment on earth—the famous Kilauea volcano. Explore the lush rainforests & towering sea cliffs of the Hamakua Coastline, and cascading waterfalls of the Kohala Mountains. Volcanic activity varies hourly.



2 Circle Of Fire Plus Waterfalls

Tour the most geologically active environment on earth, with the emphasis on the most current areas of volcanic activity. Look for lava flows, black sand beaches, and waterfalls from the comfort and safety of your million dollar aircraft. **Hilo departure**



3 Airplane Tour

4 Catamaran Snorkel Cruise

Experience the Kona coastline by catamaran. Snorkel among the abundant marine life within the coral and lava rock reefs. Waters are so pristine, often with visibility up to 100 feet. The view is incredible even from the top deck! (Continental breakfast, BBQ lunch, snorkel gear, and instruction included).



5 Snorkel Raft Adventure

Explore sea caves and lava tubes along the Kona coast. Snorkel at premier marine sanctuaries seeing many species of fish, eels, turtles, and coral. The adventure continues as we head out to find the dolphins and whales in season.



6 Manta Ray Encounter

Snorkel and/or scuba with these gentle giants as they feed on a buffet of plankton attracted to our lights. There are hundreds of manta rays along the Kona coast. Up to 16 ft. from wing tip to wing tip, this is one of the safest marine animal encounters in the world!



7 Scuba Diving

Hawai'i has the clearest blue crystal waters of all the Hawaiian islands. Lava formations with walls, archways, lava-tubes, and abundant marine life. No experience necessary. Introductory dives include all the gear and instruction! A certified diver's paradise.



8 Atlantis Submarine

A voyage of discovery that will take you into another world! Descend to depths of over 100 feet in the safety and air conditioned comfort of a real submarine to explore natural coral reefs and their colorful marine inhabitants. Everyone gets a window seat. Minimum height is 36 inches.
