## H2 2023

- Gain a deeper understanding of the bibliometric datasets underlying your institutions ranking scores in 2024 QS and THE World University Rankings.
- Evaluate the research performance of Chinese scholars with access to the 2021 and 2022 lists of Highly Cited Chinese Researchers, generated using Scopus® data and a method developed by ShanghaiRanking Consultancy.
- Create and analyze larger entities immediately through an increased publication limit for dynamic entities.
- Understand your contribution towards the UN SDGs through SDGs as subject classification.
- Analyze the output and impact of academic collaboration with all other sectors in the Benchmarking module.
- Compare your collaborators by their overall rank in major university rankings in Collaboration module tables.
- Track how your Institution's collaborations have developed in specific fields over time with the yearly collaboration breakdown by subject area in the Collaboration module.

• Analyze an Institution's funding portfolio, overall or per Subject Area, through acknowledgement Linked publications by Funding Body in the Grants module.
