
## **Health & Place and Wellbeing, Space and Society**

15 international ECRs have joined the two Early Career Editorial Boards and are being supported by the EiCs on handling journal-related activities.




### **Urban Transitions**

Annual Reviewer Research Grant to help early career reviewers advance their research.




### **African Transport Studies and Latin American Transport Studies**

Supporting the International Conference of Historical Geographers in Shanghai, China, 2025, with editor sessions and an author workshop.




## **World Development**
