



ACCESSIBILITY IN KURSAAL CONGRESS CENTRE

Main entrance:

- 2 contiguous doors open inwards (double leaf-door). Clear passage width: more than 80cm (31.50 inches) each.

- Registration desk: lowered counter.

Access to different areas:

- There are guide borders to the flooring with a different texture/ level before and after the stairs.

Lifts:

- Lifts are available to access all areas: meeting rooms 1-9 and Banquet Hall. Chamber Hall and Room 10 are located at street level. There is also a lift in Auditorium to access upper levels.

- Lift door is 80cm wide (31.50 inches).

Toilets:

Accessible toilets are available in all floor levels:

- Generic toilet with two folding bars. Space for lateral and frontal transfers: more than 80cm (31.50 inches).
- Bathroom sink without pedestal to allow frontal access.
- Self-closing bathroom sink faucet

Chamber Hall:

- Space reserved for persons with reduced mobility (the 1st row of the hall can be dismantled to place wheelchairs, but we need to be worn in advance): 26 stalls in all.

Auditorium:

- Space reserved for persons with reduced mobility (all stalls in row 17 can be dismantled to place wheelchairs, but we need to be worn in advance): 42 stalls in all.

Other:

- Relief signage.
- Braille signage.
- 1 wheelchair available.
- Magnetic loop system available in our translation receivers.
