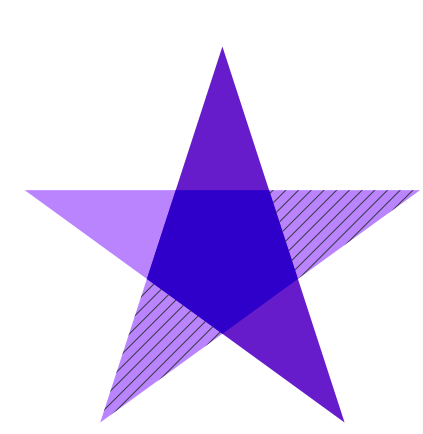

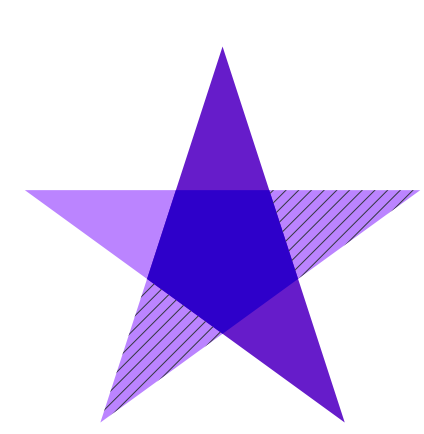

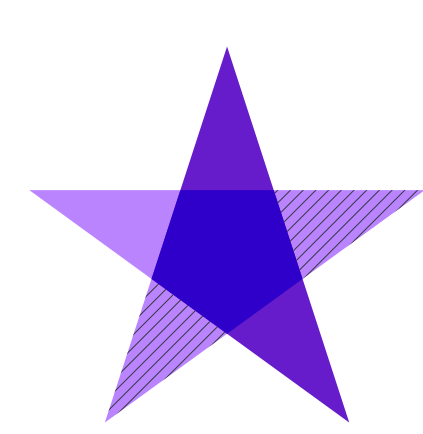
Zhou Enlai

First Premier of the People's Republic of China, head of government from 1949-1976



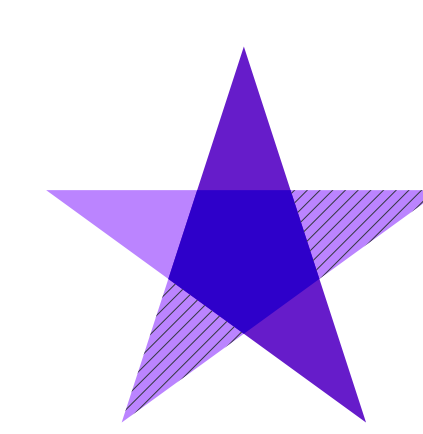
Wu Ta-You

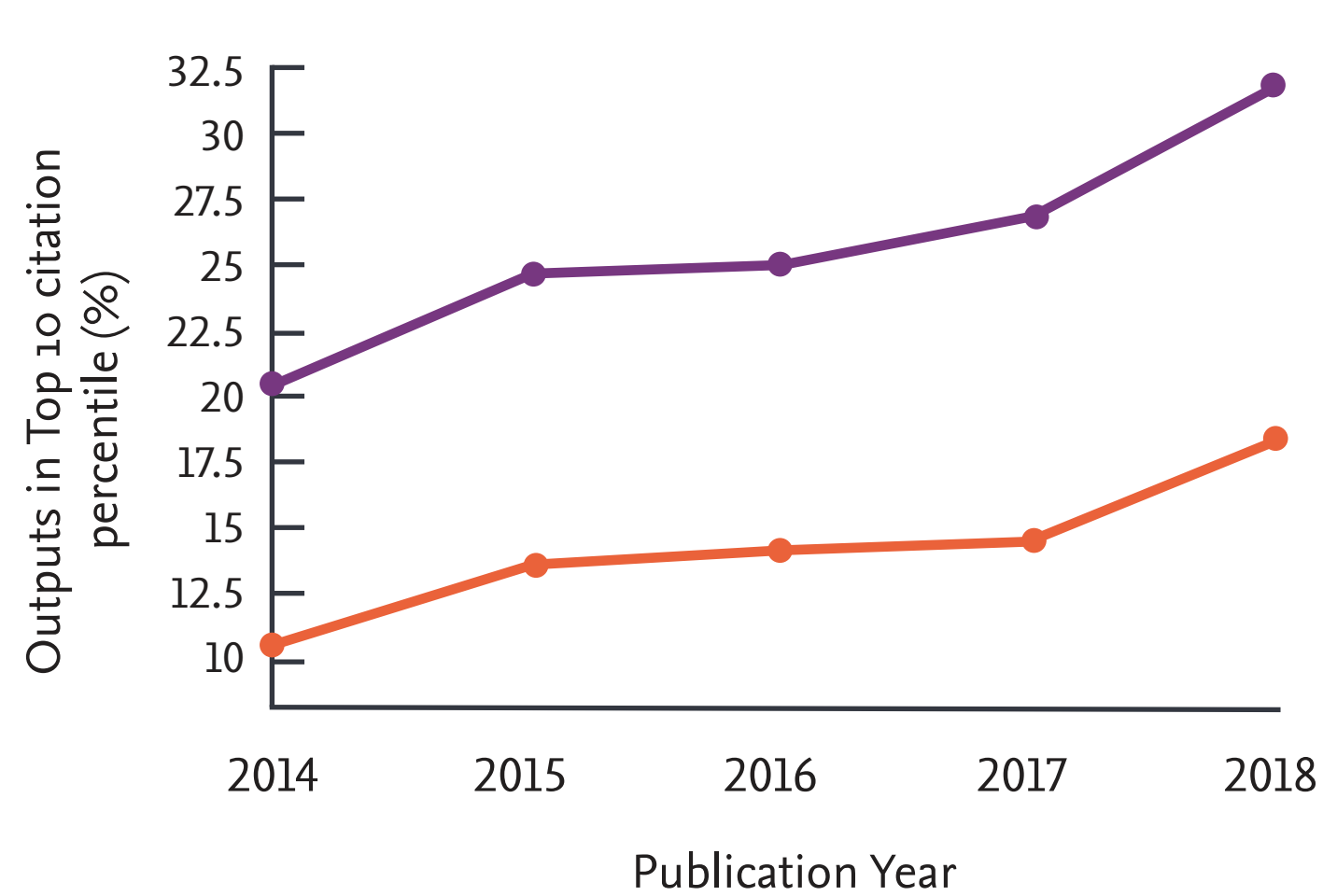

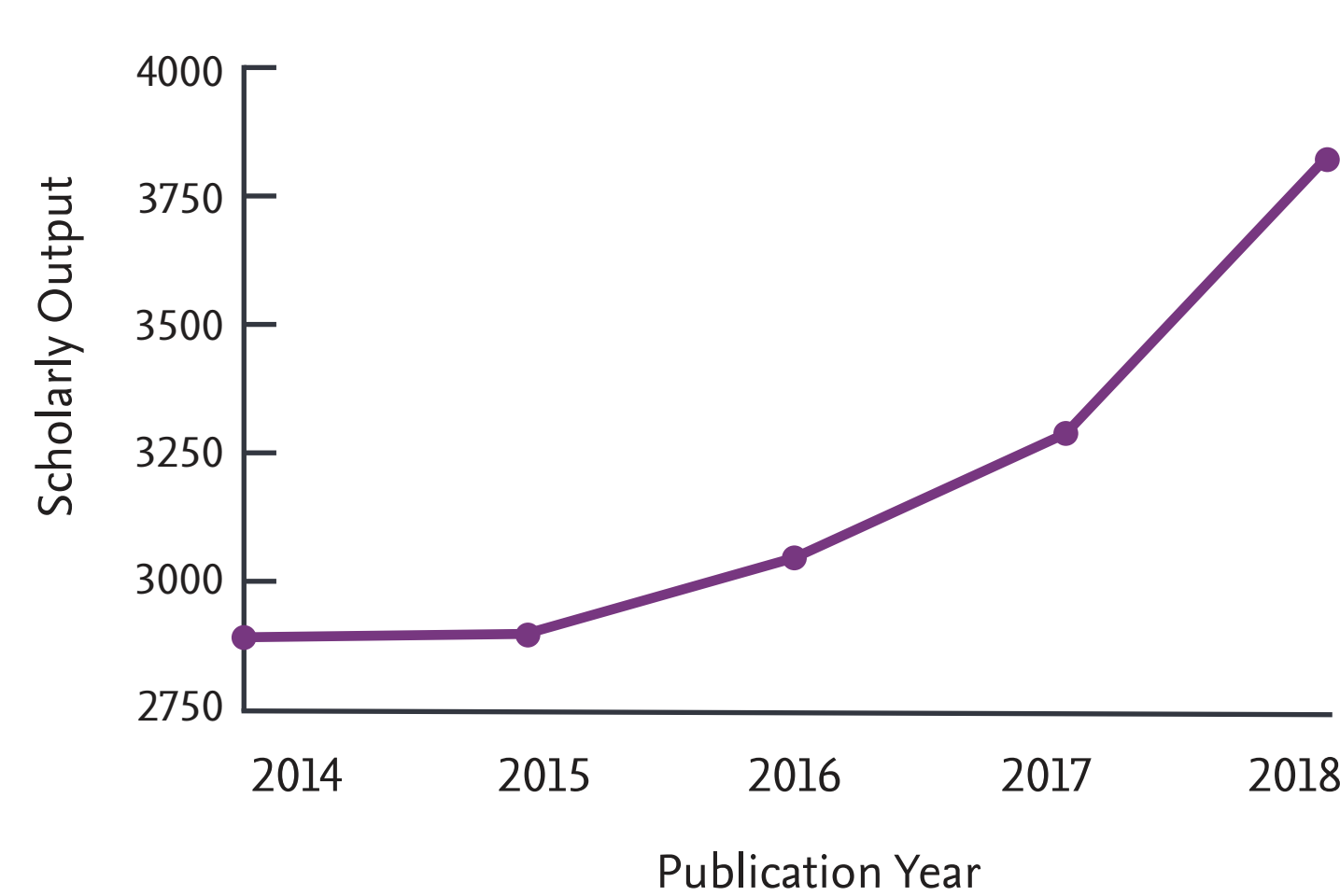

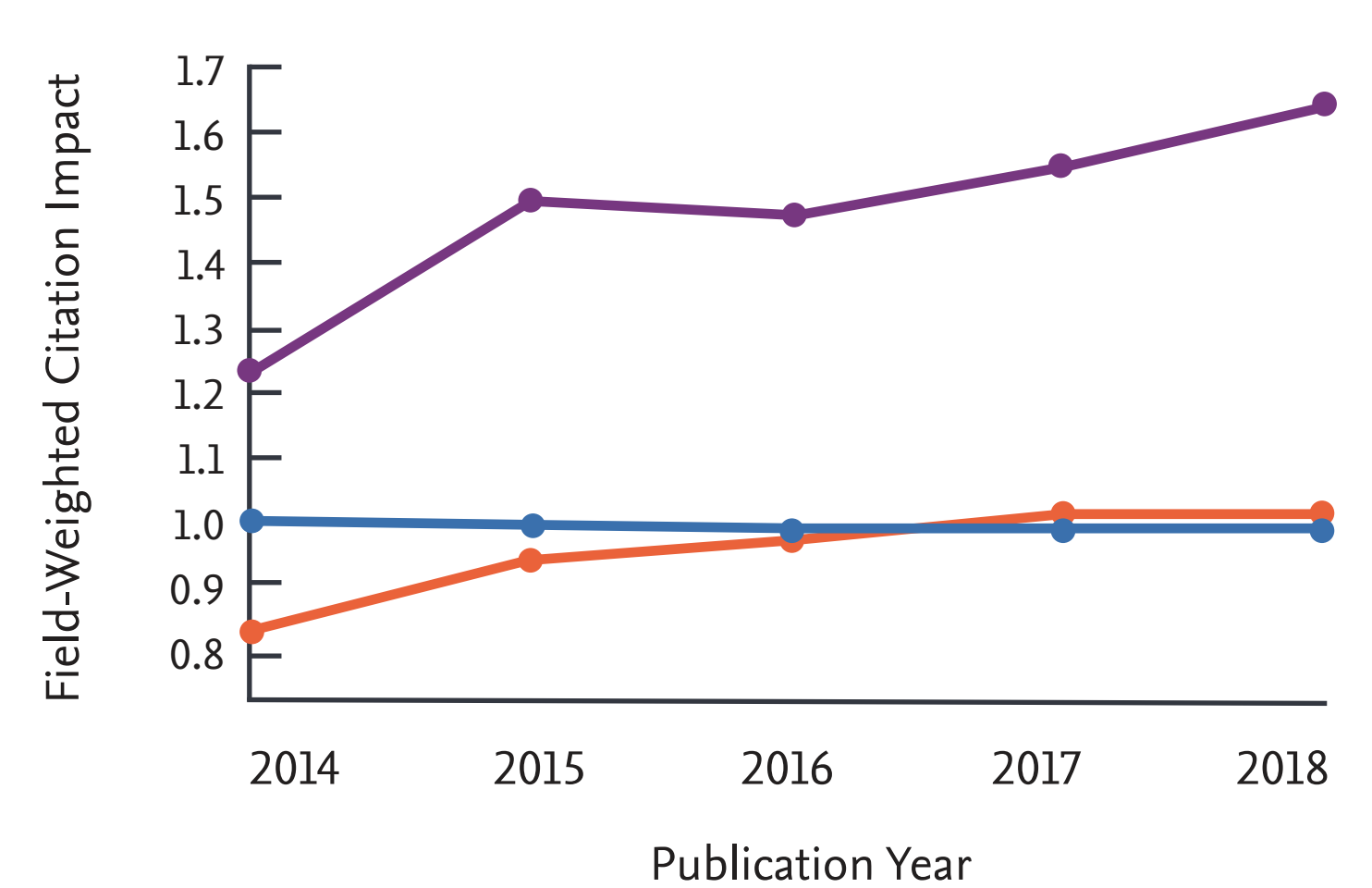
Nankai in top 10%

Nankai Field-Weighted Citation Impact



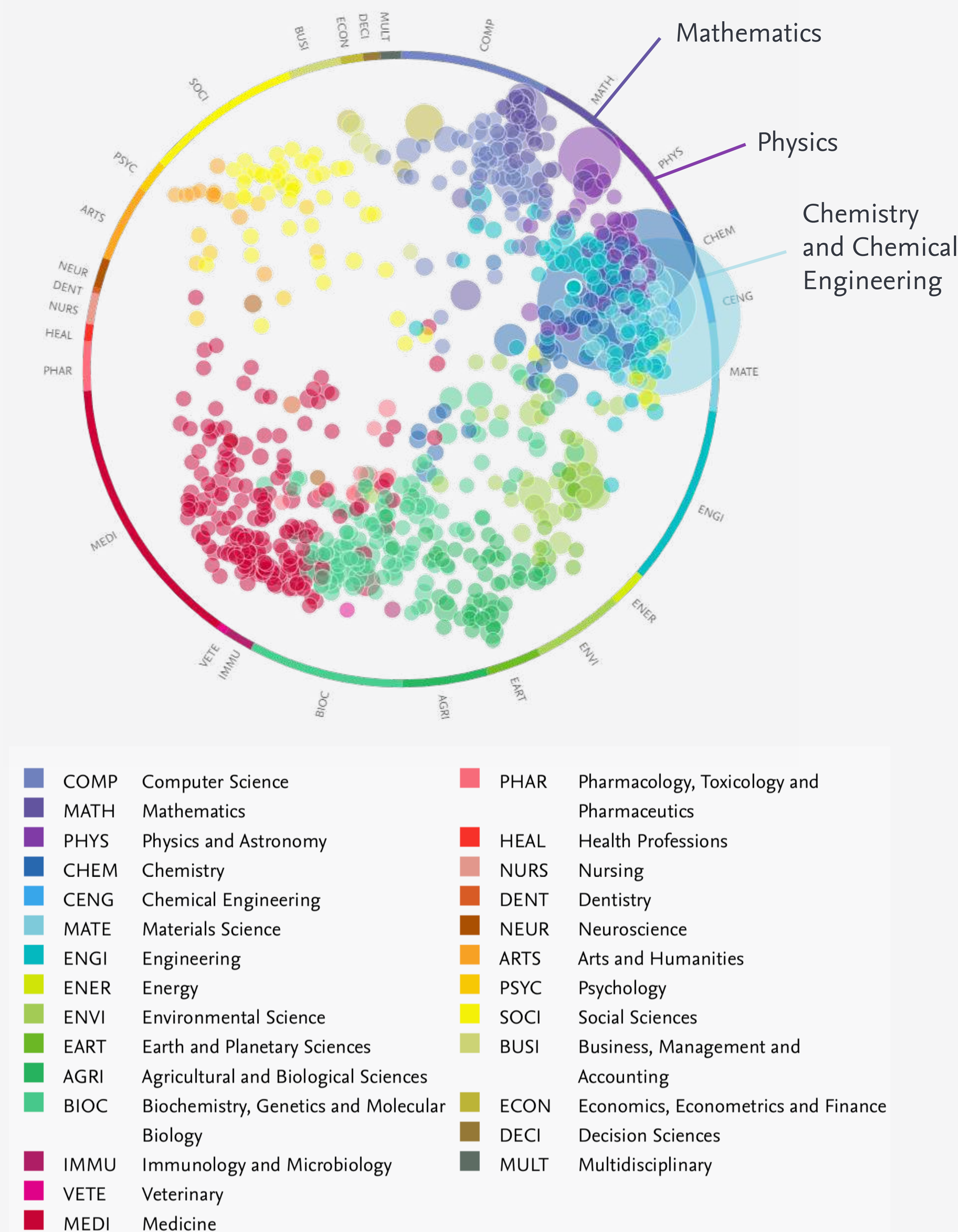

Research topic prominence percentile

Calculating a Topic's Prominence combines 3 metrics to indicate the momentum of the Topic:

- **Citation Count** in year n to papers published in n and n-1
- **Scopus Views Count** in year n to papers published in n and n-1
- **Average CiteScore** for year n

15.6% China overall

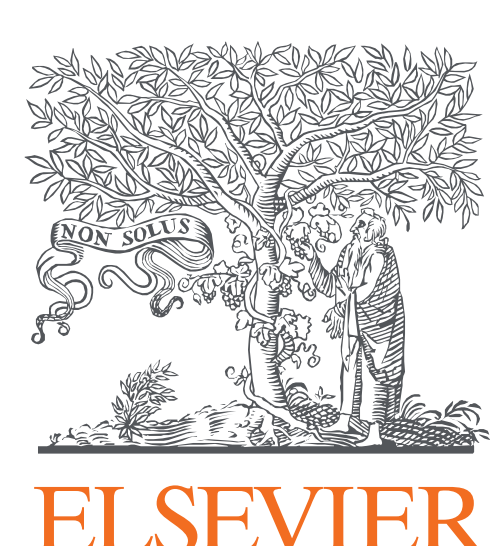
44.7% publications in top 10% journals by CiteScore Percentile
