








Zhou Enlai First Premier of the People's Republic of China, head of government from 1949-1976





Nankai Field-Weighted Citation Impact




Research topic prominence percentile

Calculating a Topic's Prominence combines 3 metrics to indicate the momentum of the Topic:


- Citation Count in year n to papers published in n and n-1
