**Product Description:** Floq is a digital platform by Conference Compass for managing event experiences via web and mobile apps, offering agenda access, speaker info, engagement tools, and personalized planning.

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**Notes:** This VPAT covers the accessibility status of the Floq web and mobile apps as of the report date. Accessibility improvements are included in future product releases.

**Evaluation Methods Used:** Manual and automated WCAG 2.2 testing; EN 301 549 mapping; usage of screen readers, keyboard navigation, and responsive testing.

**Applicable Standards/Guidelines:** This report covers the degree of conformance for the following accessibility standards/guidelines: EN 301 549 v3.2.1 (2021-03); WCAG 2.2 Level A and AA.

### Terms

The terms used in the Conformance Level information are defined as follows:

- **Supports**: The functionality of the product has at least one method that meets the criterion without known defects or meets with equivalent facilitation.
- **Partially Supports**: Some functionality of the product does not meet the criterion.
