Do you know what steps to take after an injury on a construction site?

1 Assess the injury and seek medical attention if necessary.



2 Make a written record of it in either an accident book or as a first aid record. It must be written down.



3 If possible, take photographs of the accident.

Identify any witnesses of the accident and get their details.

Keep a diary and note of all your expenses and keep receipts as these costs will mount up.

5

Go to your GP and report your symptoms and injuries straight away. For serious injuries, hospital admission would mean the injuries are recorded in any event.

7

You have up to three years to claim from the date the injury occurred.
