









How to identify ICE &CBP







Immigration & Customs Enforcement:

primarily locate, detain, and deport

undocumented immigrants, often

targeting individuals in homes,

workplaces, and communities.

Both ICE and CBP agents:

- · Wear street/ casual clothes.
- Bulletproof vests.
- Often carry firearms, handcuffs, radios, and other law enforcement tools.
- When conducting raids or enforcement actions, they may wear helmets, gloves, and protective gear.







Customs & Border Protection: monitor and control U.S. borders, inspecting goods and people entering the country, while enforcing immigration laws and policies.



How to Identify ICE &CBP Vehicles



CBP

- · Blue on the sides.
- Tinted windows.
- US Customs & Border Logo.
- · Lights on top of car.
- CBP uses white SUVs, pickup trucks, vans, and ATVs, boats and aircraft.



- · Green on the sides.
- · Tinted windows.
- · Lights on top of the car.
- ICE uses SUVs, sedans, or vans, often white, black, or neutral-colored.





- . Can be CBP or ICE.
- · Tinted windows.
- May be "unmarked" or have no license plates.
- · May have lights on top of car.

- ICE opera en la madrugada;

- Tienen vidrios polarizados y a veces se logra ver rejillas;
- Siempre hay una persona en los vehículos y operan en pares.

HOW TO IDENTIFY ICE VEHICLES?

- ICE usually operates in the predawn early mornings hours;
- 2) They use U.S. made cars;
- Usually have regular license plates (not-CA exempt), at times no license plates or dealership placards;
- 4) They use ultra dark tinted windows; and have police railing in the rear passenger area.
- There is always an agent in the vehicle, and usually operate in pairs.

ICE Unmarked Cars

ICE agents drive unmarked vehicles
(without license plates, or with new plates
without numbers)

- These cars almost always have tinted windows
- American brand cars such as Ford, are most commonly seen
