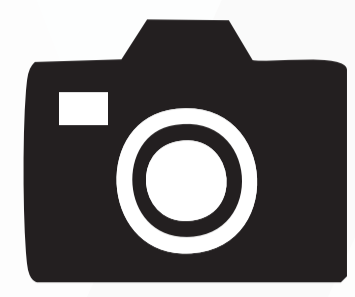

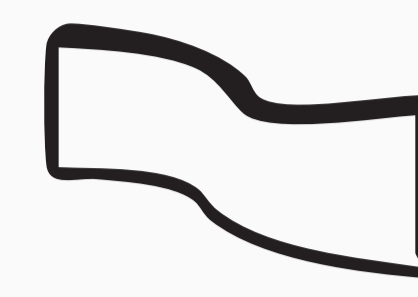
Small compact cameras
