# A If you forget to give the medicine

If you forget a dose, give the next dose when needed. Do not give a double dose.

# 4. Possible side-effects

This medicine is unlikely to cause side-effects unless your child is allergic to the ingredients. If your child experiences any of the following, stop giving the medicine and seek immediate medical help. See a doctor at once:

Unexplained wheezing or difficulty in breathing, swelling of the face, lips, tongue, neck or throat (severe allergic reactions).

If your child experiences any other side-effects not listed here or if you are not sure about anything, talk to your doctor or pharmacist.

# Reporting of side-effects

If you get any side-effects, talk to your doctor, pharmacist or nurse. This includes any possible side-effects not listed on this carton. This includes any possible side-effects not listed on this carton. #### 5. Storing this medicine

Do not give this medicine after the expiry date shown on the bottle. Keep the bottle tightly closed. There are no special storage instructions for this medicine. Keep out of the sight and reach of children. Medicines should not be disposed of via wastewater or household waste. Ask your pharmacist how to dispose of medicines no longer required. These measures will help to protect the environment. Retain carton for full instructions

#### 6. Further information: What's in this medicine

The active ingredients in each 5 ml of medicine are: Glycerol 0.75 ml and Sucrose 1.7 g.

Other ingredients are: Citric acid monohydrate, sodium benzoate (E211), anthocyanin, blackcurrant flavour and juice (containing propylene glycol (E1520) and benzyl alcohol), liquid glucose and purified water.

What the medicine looks like: Benvlin Children's Dry Cough & Sore Throat Syrup is a clear, purple liquid available in 125 ml bottles. If you need more advice ask your pharmacist.

#### 1. What this medicine is for

This medicine relieves irritating, dry coughs and sore throats.

2. Before giving the medicine to your child

This product is suitable for most people, but a few people should not use it. If you are in any doubt contact your doctor or pharmacist.

#### Do not give your child this medicine...

If s/he is under 1 year old. If s/he is allergic to any of the ingredients. If any of these bullet points apply, get advice from a doctor or pharmacist without using this medicine.

#### Talk to your doctor or pharmacist

If your child has an intolerance to some sugars. If this applies to your child now or in the past, talk to a doctor or pharmacist.

#### A Some of the ingredients can cause problems

- This product contains 2.15 g glucose and 1.7 g sucrose in each 5 ml. which may be harmful to the teeth. If you have been told by your doctor that your child has an intolerance to some sugars, contact your doctor before using this medicine. This should be taken into account in patients with diabetes.
- Carbohydrate content of this medicine is 3.4 g per 5 ml.
- This medicine contains 3.53mg propylene glycol (E1520) in each 5ml dose, which is equivalent to 0.71mg/ml.
- This medicine contains 10 mg sodium benzoate (E211) in each 5ml which is equivalent to 2 g/ml
- This medicine contains less than 1 mmol sodium (23 mg) per 5 ml. that is to say essentially 'sodium-free'.
- This medicine contains 0.000053 mg benzyl alcohol in each 5ml which is equivalent to 0.000011 mg/ml. Benzyl alcohol may cause allergic reactions. Ask your doctor or pharmacist for advice if you are pregnant or breast-feeding or if you have a liver or kidney disease. This is because large amounts of benzyl alcohol can build-up in your body and may cause side effects (called "metabolic acidosis"). Do not use for more than a week in young children (less than 3 years old). unless advised by your doctor or pharmacist. This is due to an increased risk due to accumulation in young children.

# 3. How to use this medicine

Check the information below to see how much medicine to give.

- For oral use only. Do not give more medicine than the carton (and/or label) tells you to.
- Do not overfill the spoon. There is a double-ended spoon in the pack. Check the cap seal is not broken before first use. If it is, do not take this medicine.

# Children under 1 vear

# Do not give to children under 1 year old.

# Children 1 year and over and Adults

AGE	DOSE
Children 1 – 5 years	One 5 ml spoonful.
Children 5 years and over and adults (including the elderly)	Two 5 ml spoonfuls.

Give the dose 3 or 4 times within 24 hours, if needed

If your child does not feel better or starts to feel worse, tell your doctor or pharmacist.

You can take this medicine if you are pregnant or breastfeeding.

# A If anyone has taken too much

If anyone has taken too much of this product, contact a doctor or your nearest Accident & Emergency department (Casualty), taking this pack with you.

#### DOSE: For oral use only.

Use the measuring spoon provided. Children 1-5 years:

# One 5 ml spoonful.

Children 5 years and over (including adults and the elderly): Two 5 ml spoonfuls.

Not suitable for children under 1 year.

Give the dose 3 or 4 times in 24 hours, if needed. Please tell your doctor or pharmacist if your child does not feel better or starts to feel worse. Read and retain carton for full instructions Keep the bottle tightly closed.

#### CONTENTS

Each 5 ml of oral liquid contains: Glycerol 0.75 ml. Sucrose 1.7q. Other ingredients include: Liquid glucose 2.15 g. E1520, E211. benzvl alcohol. Carbohydrate content 3.4 g per 5 ml. There are no special storage instructions.

Keep all medicines out of the sight and reach of children.
