1. Overview

1.1. Neonode Safeguards Your Personal Integrity

This policy describes which cookies Neonode uses and how they are used, as well as how you can prevent cookies from being stored on your device. 1.2. What is a Cookie?

A cookie is a small piece of text sent to your browser by a website you visit. It helps the site remember information about your visit, which can make it easier to visit the site again and make the site more useful to you.

1.3. Definitions

2. Types of Cookies Used

This section describes the cookies used by Neonode. Some or all of the cookies listed below may be stored in your browser.

2.1. Strictly Necessary Cookies

Strictly necessary cookies are essential for you to browse a website and use its features, such as accessing secure areas of the site. Cookies that allow web shops to hold your items in your cart while you are shopping online are an example of strictly necessary cookies. These cookies will generally be first-party session cookies. Neonode does not use strictly necessary cookies.

2.2. Functional Cookies

Functional cookies improve the user experience on Neonode websites by enabling basic functions like remembering choices you have made in the past. Functional cookies are only used if you have given us your consent for such cookies.

2.3. Statistics Cookies
