What is a when-then sentence?

Teachers and other adults use a when-then sentence to help kids stay on track. The sentence tells kids what they're expected to do, and what good things will happen when they do it. Kids and adults can come up with the positive outcomes together.

Example: When you clean up your desk, then you can play outside.
