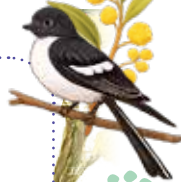


DjilBA

August–September

Djilba, the **season of Conception** shows a transitional period with a mix of cold, warm, rainy, and windy days. Traditional Aboriginal life adapted to these changes, continuing to rely on land-based animals like yonga (kangaroo), weitj (emu), and koomal (possum) as primary food sources. Djilba's name reflects the arrival of baby animals and the protective behaviour of birds like koolbardi (magpie), djidi djidi (willie wagtails), and wattle birds.

Recognising Noongar Seasons' environmental and cultural significance deepens our connection to the land, traditional practices, and community celebrations in Armadale, Western Australia.
