

Register of Complaints (Minor Breach Findings)

The Local Government Act 1995 requires the City to publish an up-to-date Register in accordance with section 5.121

5.121.Register of certain complaints of minor breaches

- The complaints officer for each local government is required to maintain a register of complaints which records all complaints that result in a finding under section 5.110(2)(a) that a minor breach has occurred.
- (2) The register of complaints is to include, for each recorded complaint —
- (a) the name of the council member about whom the complaint is made; and
- (b) the name of the person who makes the complaint; and
- (c) a description of the minor breach that the standards panel finds has occurred; and
- details of the action taken under section 5.110(6).
- (3) The CEO must publish an up-to-date version of the register of complaints on the local government's official website. More information on the Local Government Standards Panel can be foundLocal Government Standards Panel
