Putting your bins out for collection



Place bins out by 6am on your collection day



Maximum weight of each bin is 70kg



Do not park in front of bins and keep laneways clear



Make sure your bin lid is closed



Keep at least **1m clear** from trees and not under tree canopy

Keep at least **0.5m clear** between bins



Keep at least **1m clear** of cars, mailboxes and fences etc.

Please note the following changes to collection days due to major public holidays:

No collection on Thursday 1 January (New Year's Day), collection is scheduled for Friday 2 January. Subsequently, Friday's collection will be emptied on Saturday.

No collection on Friday 3 April (Good Friday), collection is scheduled for Saturday 4 April.

No collection on Friday 25 December (Christmas Day), collection is scheduled for Saturday 26 December.

What happens to my waste after the general waste bin is collected?

Residential general waste from residents now goes to the Kwinana Energy Recovery plant, Australia's first of its kind. Instead of landfill, this waste is used to generate enough electricity for 55,000 homes. Reducing landfill lowers greenhouse gas emissions, and by-products from the process are used in materials like road sub-base and building blocks.



Roleystone Green Waste Facility

The Roleystone Green Waste Facility is open on specific days from 8am - 4.45pm (last entry 4.30pm). All residents are eligible to dispose of green waste at Roleystone Green Waste Facility, located at Springdale Road, Roleystone.

Note: Residential quantities only. Fees and charges apply. Evidence of City of Armadale residency is required. **Mulch is not available** from the Roleystone Green Waste Facility due to the risk of Polyphagous Shot-Hole Borer (PSHB).

- Take photographs of anything suspicious
- Include a pen or a ruler in your photographs for scale



Booked mattress collections

Scan the QR code to view your verge collection dates for 2026.



Green waste verge collections

WHAT WILL BE COLLECTED

Tree and shrub prunings up to:

- ✓ 1.5 metres in length
- ✓ Up to 30cm diameter only
- ✓ 4.5 cubic metres.

Green waste can be placed on the verge up to 2 days prior to the collection start date. Scan the QR code to view your green waste verge collection dates for 2026.



WARNING - In the event of a Total Fire Ban collections may be suspended until the all clear is given.

WHAT WILL NOT BE COLLECTED

- ✗ Boxes or bags of leaves or grass clippings
- ✗ Dug out lawn, sand or soil
- ✗ Long branches (over 1.5m)
- ✗ Garden chemicals, garden pots or reticulation
- ✗ General waste
- ✗ Sawn and treated timber
- ✗ Green waste that is secured with ties, or placed near services, reticulation, walls or structures
- ✗ Green waste on vacant land or public reserves
- ✗ Mulch.



Bulk waste verge collection

PLEASE DO

- ✓ Place waste neatly on your verge on the allocated weekend
- ✓ Allow 10 working days for collection
- ✓ Keep checking your pile as it is your responsibility to ensure bulk waste remains tidy until collected
- ✓ Secure bulk waste on your property if strong winds are forecast, or a severe weather warning is issued.

PLEASE DON'T

- ✗ Place your bulk waste on any other verge as it WILL NOT be collected from vacant land or public reserves
- ✗ Obstruct the footpath or the line of sight for pedestrians, cyclists and cars
- ✗ Exceed the allowed volume of bulk waste
- ✗ Place items near services, reticulation, walls, letterboxes or other structures.

WHAT WILL NOT BE COLLECTED

- ✗ Glass, mirrors, or shower screens
- ✗ Tyres or motor vehicle parts
- ✗ TV's, computers, printers, stereos and speakers
- ✗ Mattresses
- ✗ Beanbags
- ✗ All building materials, bricks, paving, tiles, toilet cisterns, concrete, wire, sand or cement
- ✗ Asbestos or other fibrous cement products
- ✗ Garden or food waste
- ✗ Fire Extinguishers, EPIRBs or flares
- ✗ Hazardous waste ie chemicals, oils, paint, pesticides, solvents, batteries, gas bottles or smoke detectors
- ✗ Items over 1.8 metres in length
- ✗ Unsorted bulk waste.

For safety, the facility may also close during extreme weather conditions.

Drop off recyclables and other materials: Separate your load

RECYCLING

Steel and aluminium, clean flattened cardboard, Electronic Waste, Mattresses, Tyres, Motor Oil, Car Batteries.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

20 kilos or litres per material type *PER VISIT*

Gas bottles, paint, fluoro globes/tubes, smoke detectors, household chemicals, fire extinguishers and boat flares (no EPIRB).

METAL WASTE

Scrap metal, white goods, fencing, sheet metal, car parts, bikes and lawnmowers.

GREEN WASTE

Tree and shrub prunings, stumps up to 300mm in diameter, grass clippings and leaves.

BUILDING WASTE

Timber, brick rubble, fibrous sheets and sand (must be separated into individual waste streams).

MIXED WASTE

Broken items that cannot be reused, recycled or composted.



Up to 5kg of asbestos is accepted Mon to Fri between 8.30am and 12.30pm. Residents only. Strict acceptance guidelines must be followed.


