



LP6 – Commodity Fumigation License Exam Summary

The LP6 exam is 70 questions consisting of multiple choice, true/false and fill in the blank, and is generated from a bank of approximately 165 questions. The exam is on a computer and administered in-person at the LDAF main office in Baton Rouge, or online proctored through Everblue.
