These rates may be changed **ONLY** after 30 day notice approval by the Louisiana Agricultural Commodities Commission Director. When there is a change in the charges or tariffs, a new schedule must be filed with the Commission **PRIOR** to implementation. Each schedule shall be posted conspicuously in each location covered by the warehouse license.
