Reporting to the Senior Manager, Animal Care (or designate), the Animal Care Supervisor is responsible for overseeing the daily operations of the Animal Care team. This includes ensuring the health and welfare of animals, maintaining high standards of cleanliness and safety, and supporting staff, volunteers, and other departments.

As a forward-thinking team player, you thrive in a dynamic and sometimes challenging environment, balancing multiple demands while fostering collaboration and compassion.

What you will be doing:

- Supervising and mentoring Animal Care staff
- Developing and managing staff schedules
- Coordinating training for staff, volunteers, and co-op students
- Supporting emergency boarding and reclaims in collaboration with Community Outreach
- Responding to adoption inquiries and assist with adoption returns
- Overseeing identification and intake procedures for stray animals
- Assisting with animal handling, feeding, and cleaning as needed
- Managing Return to Field (RTF) and Barn Buddy programs
- Leading the high school co-op program
- Collecting and reporting monthly departmental statistics
- Ensuring compliance with cleaning and disinfection protocols
- Maintaining professional standards and contributing to a positive workplace culture

Qualifications:

- Post-secondary education in Animal Care or related field is preferred
- Minimum one year of supervisory/management experience
- Knowledge in Animal Welfare practices relating to animal sheltering, adoptions and euthanasia is preferred
- Strong leadership, communication, organizational, and multitasking skills
- Ability to manage physical demands and work in emotionally challenging environments
- Experience handling a variety of animals
- Valid Class "G" Ontario driver's license
